100 crafts *under one roof*

All of Preciosa's work is done under one roof where one hundred professions come together to craft the perfect light. From the first sketch to the mock-up to production to finishing and assembling, Preciosa's professional team ensures the highest quality and greatest attention to detail. Our advanced R&D Lab is ready to add an innovative touch. Nearly all of our production is done by hand. Glass is in our DNA; we breathe it, sculpt it, refine and shape it.



Glass is processed and shaped using various techniques - blowing, casting, pressing, or pulling. It's not only hard work, years of training and skill, it's also a feeling, working with the breath and other experiences you can only gain by spending time with the glass.



Semi-finished glass products move from the glassworks to the glass cutting line for final finishing. Here each piece goes through several stages of cutting and polishing, two areas that are always performed by hand at Preciosa.





Preciosa is one of the few companies in the world that still controls the technology of metal casting into sand moulds. Its particular advantages include a higher artistic level of castings and the possibility of piece production for unique components.



We assemble and evaluate every light prior to it leaving the factory. This is to ensure the fixture is well made from both a technical and design perspective. Research, design, construction, engineering and more teams are involved in this final quality check.





Our in-house designers take inspiration from the design, use, and genius loci to create bespoke lighting that shines. While each of our designers utilize the latest design technology, their natural creativity expresses itself in a variety of ways.



The Ridge Stone Wall in the AC Hotel Madison Downtown is a cinematic display made up of shaped glass stones. Preciosa used more than 1200 cut crystal components for this designer wall. This magnificent project is an example of Preciosa's desire to blaze a new crystal lighting trail through technology and craft.



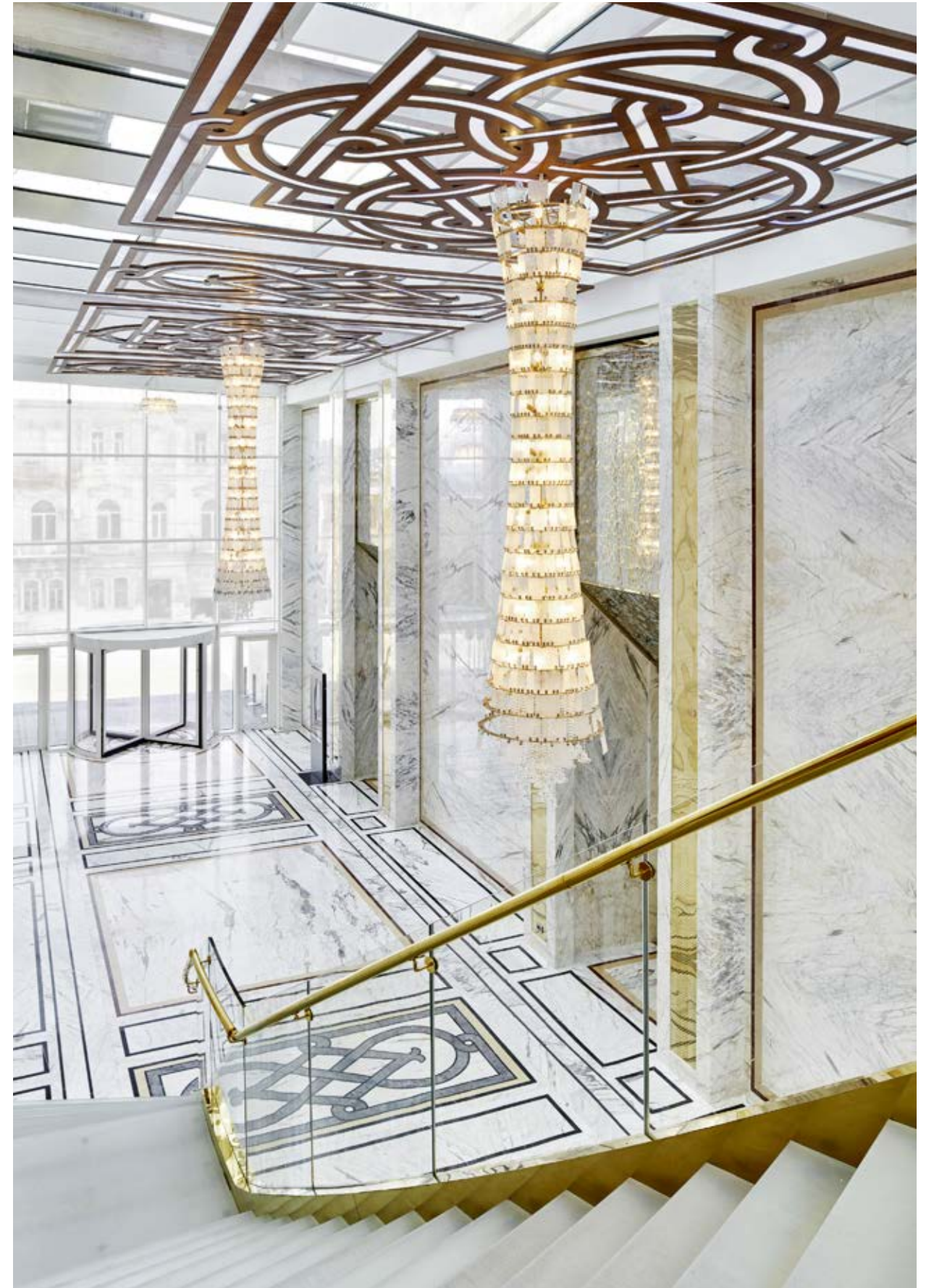

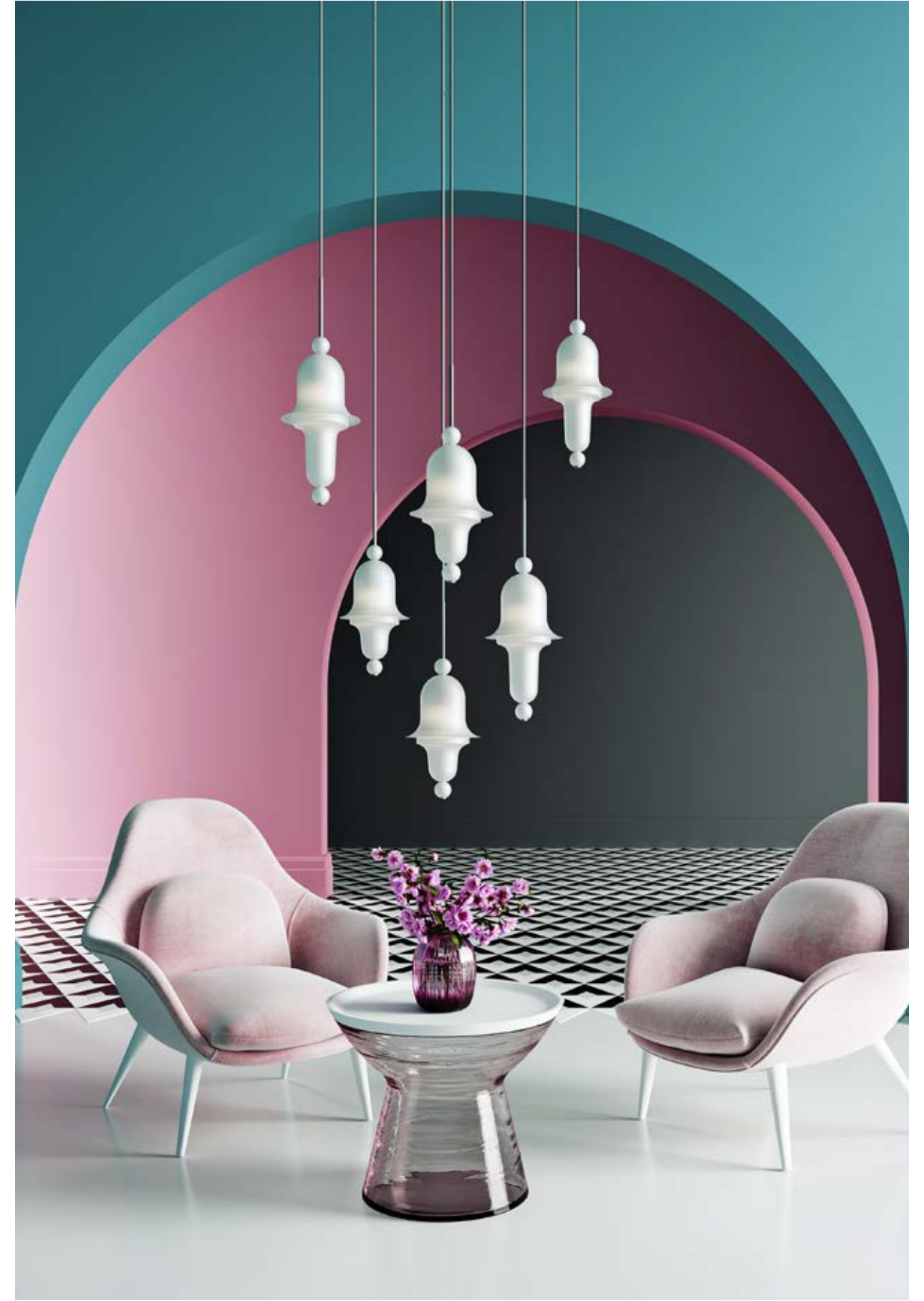

The story behind *Canopy of Light*

The desert of the United Arab Emirates can conjure up a number of images in one's mind. Hot. Dry. Dusty. Camels. But the region also has beautiful vegetation that has cunningly adapted to its environment. Inspiration from one such desert tree, the ghaf tree, has led to a captivating lighting installation now sparkling in the Mandarin Oriental Jumeira, Dubai.

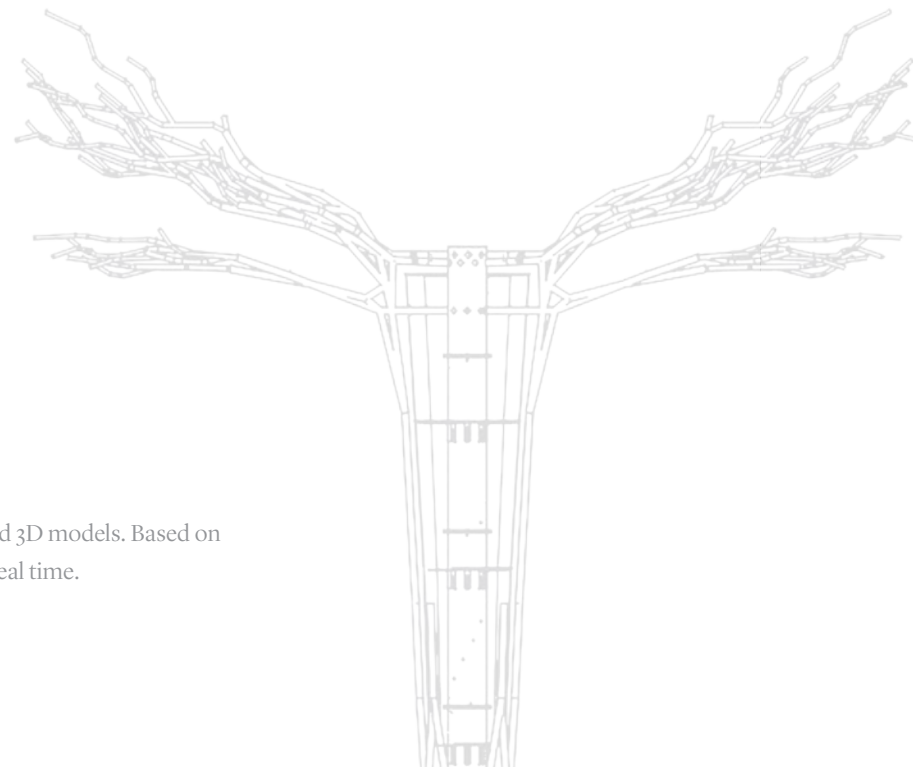
Preciosa collaborated with DESIGNWILKES to create the Canopy of Light. This is a dynamic installation featuring 14 trees in three sizes, made from hundreds of hand-blown Bohemian crystal leaves. The lights in the trees are specially programmed to produce different effects. The Mandarin Oriental has a day scene, a night scene, and then every hour the lights 'move' through the trees. Each tree is modelled separately and differently, roughly 400-500 channels, depending on the tree. This means a different light effect can be programmed to each individual tree and not necessarily the 'forest' as a whole. Motions that could be created include a downward movement of light through the trunk, a sparkling effect or a motion that looks like wind is blowing through the leaves.

TO CREATE NATURAL FEELING

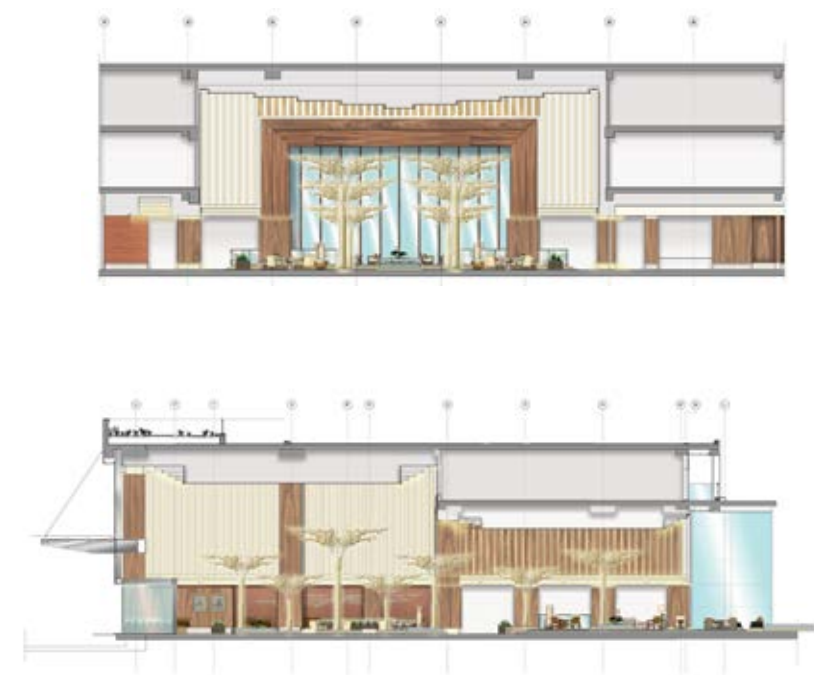




Ghaf - the UAE national tree
 A symbol of tolerance, stability and peace. A place where locals traditionally meet to discuss everyday life.



Each of the 14 luminaries and its elements were first created as detailed 3D models. Based on these, we could fine-tune the final design of the whole installation in real time.



“When visiting Dubai, we noticed the gorgeous trees full of bright orange blossoms. This was the moment we decided to create an installation under the name of Canopy of Light.” Jeffrey Wilkes, DESIGNWILKES chief designer.



The tree-tops of the lustrous forest are formed with hundreds of hand-blown Bohemian crystal leaves with a matte brass surface in champagne colour. Together, they form an impressive whole, but each one of them is still an independent programmable light.



Except for small details, the whole project was created in its entirety by Preciosa. Our experts took care of everything - from technical specifications to production and on-site installation. We created a 1:1 mock-up of a tree and invited the design team to our glass works to experience our vision in person.



Each of the 14 trees contains approximately 500 independent programmable channels. Therefore it is possible to imitate wind in the tree-tops, a twinkling firefly effect or a variety of other scenes. In addition, the trees have a special sparkle depending on whether it is day or night.

This dynamic installation features 14 individually programmable trees of light

Elegant and glamorous in every way, the Mandarin Oriental Jumeira, Dubai is located in one of the city's most gorgeous areas; the beautiful Jumeirah beachfront. Preciosa was given the mandate to create a relaxing atmosphere that connects the expansive lobby to the sparkling sea.

Preciosa underlined the warm, inviting interior with an illuminated arboretum of 14 trees that mimic the local desert flora and create a unique experience for guests.



This dynamic installation features trees in three different sizes with matte-champagne metal trunks. The trees grow into a sparkling canopy of branches filled with hundreds of hand-made crystal leaves. Each tree can be programmed to create its own lighting effect.

Preciosa also produced four large chandeliers for the Grand Ballroom and 24 modern crystal pieces were created in a similar style for the complex's meeting rooms and their foyers.

The 118 Downtown Dubai is a luxury housing complex of only 26 residences. Preciosa Lighting created signature elements to fit this premium property.

Amber Wave is a 1600kg lighting installation in the entrance lobby made from hand-blown crystal, amber, and smoky taupe glass elements. Each glass piece was individually hung by Preciosa's installation team, which took over 700 hours. The chandelier is unique in day and night conditions, reflecting natural light and lighting up brilliantly when darkness descends. Preciosa created a second lighting installation that spans the length of the space in front of the building's lifts.

Throughout the lobby, crystal and gold-plated wall scones were designed by Preciosa as were the bubbled glass door handles for the main entrance.

Al Mahara Restaurant & Gold On 27 *at Burj Al Arab Jumeirah*

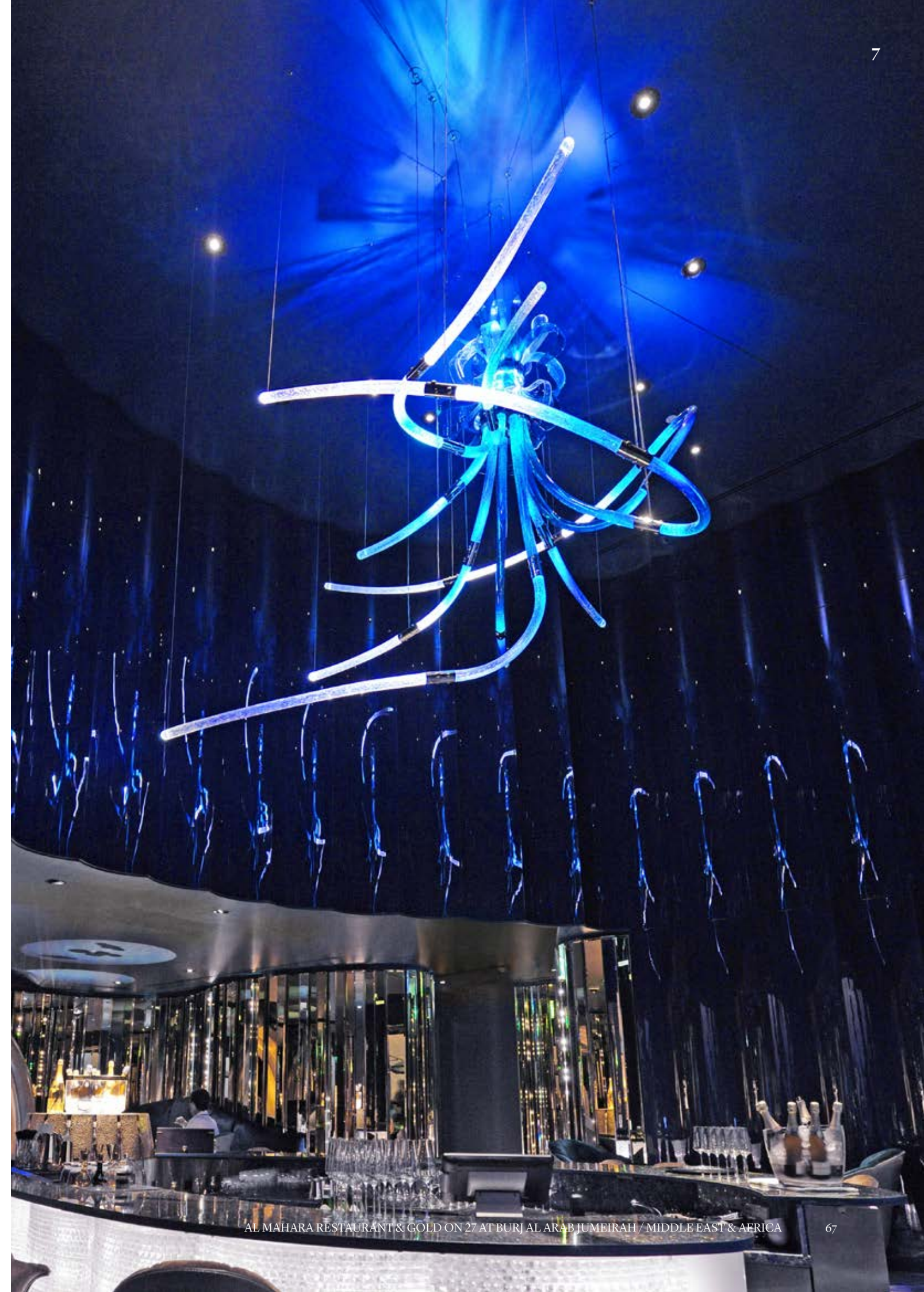
Al Mahara, an award-winning seafood restaurant, is on the first floor of Burj Al Arab Jumeirah. Preciosa designed and developed three lighting installations which are inspired by the ocean. Elegance and a passion for the mysterious octopus is embodied in an art chandelier, the main feature of the Juna Bar. It is composed of hand-blown clear and blue Bohemian crystal, inset with bubbles. A glass coral formation made up of red crystal trimmings was created for one of the private dining

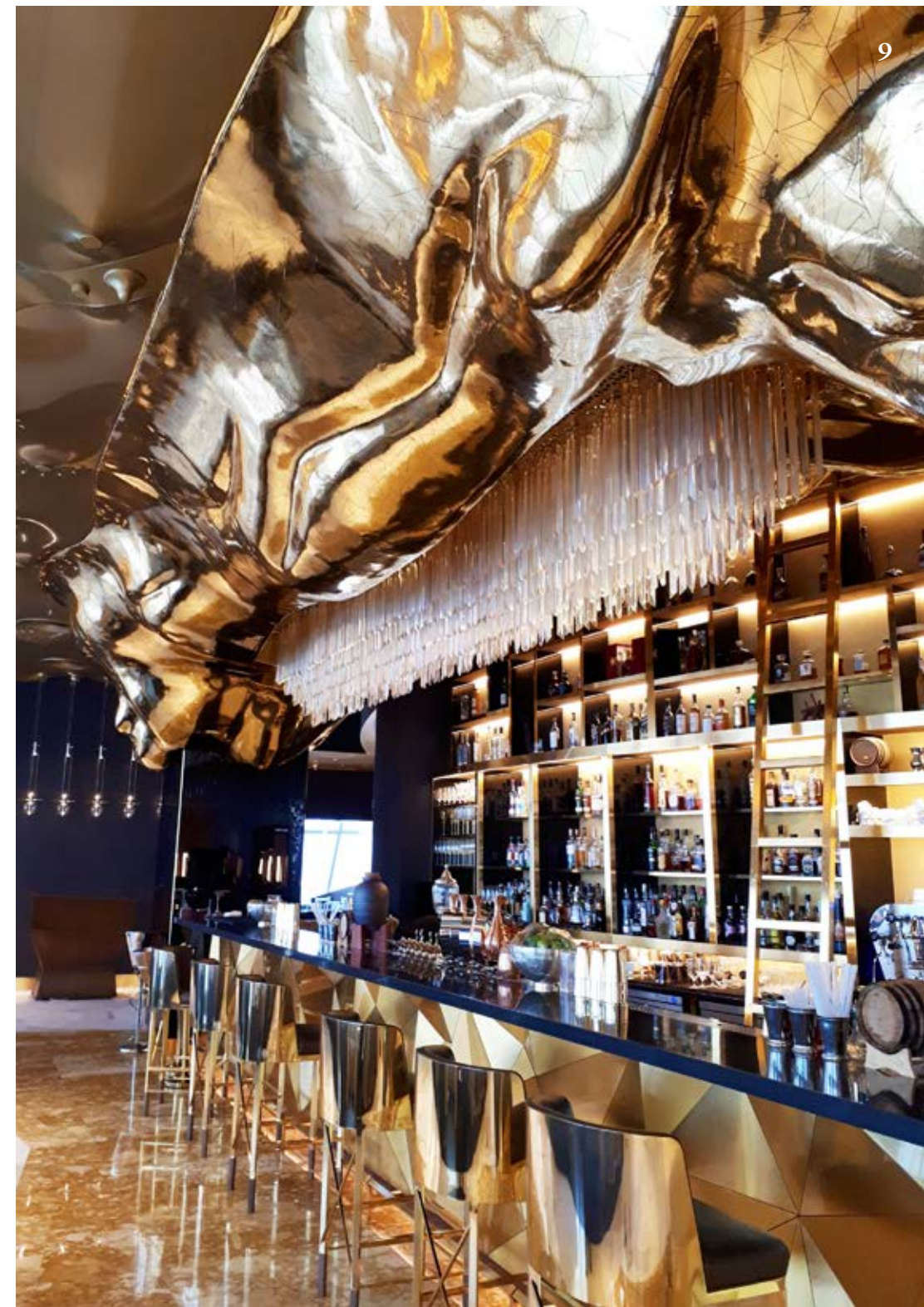
rooms. A treasure chest was the inspiration for the lighting in another private dining room. It is crafted from plates made from blown crystal, amber and champagne glass with bubbles and gold dust and cut coloured beads. In the bar on the 27th floor, a wave of gold passes across the bar. It was created from honey and clear coloured triangular rods and prisms.

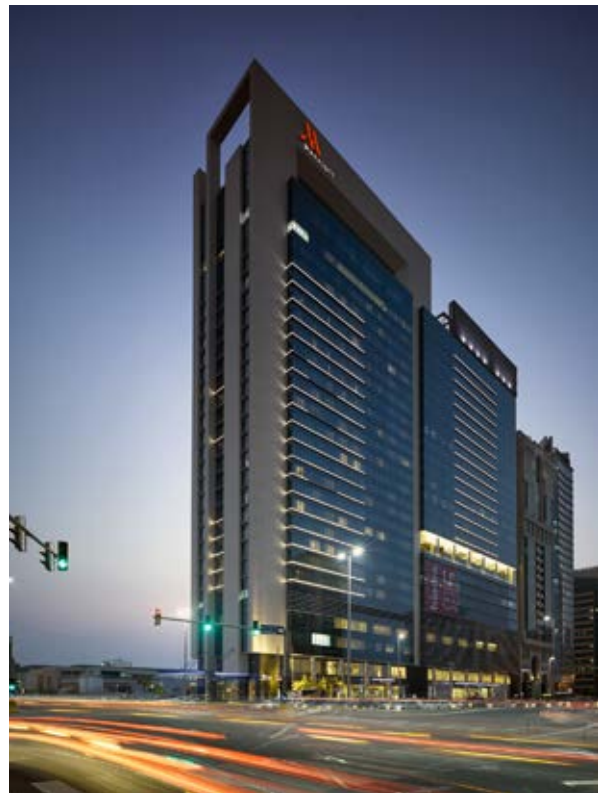


Marriott Hotel Downtown

More than half a million crystal pearls were used for the lighting installation in the atrium

The Marriott Hotel Downtown Abu Dhabi is designed to inspire and energize. The contemporary and stylish interiors blend the latest in hotel design with bold



colours, dramatic lighting, and the embrace of true comfort. Preciosa created a number of different lights throughout the property. The largest one is in the hotel atrium. This fragile beauty is created using more than half a million crystal pearls and is 28 metres long. Other beautiful crystal chandeliers enrich the hotel and banquet entrances, the lounge, the lobby corridor, and both main and junior ballrooms.

The Dubai Opera is a radiant centre of culture and arts in Dubai. The building's fascinating design has the ability to transform into three modes; from a theatre into a concert hall, and then into 'flat floor' mode, becoming a banquet or event hall.

The interior design celebrates the link to the sea, sailors, and merchants who brought wealth and prosperity to Dubai. Preciosa produced pendants and floor lamps for selected public areas. The floor lamps are almost three

metres tall and can be found sparkling on the promenade as well as the lower and upper balconies. The lamps are formed from metal and hand-blown glass leaves with a frosted surface finish.

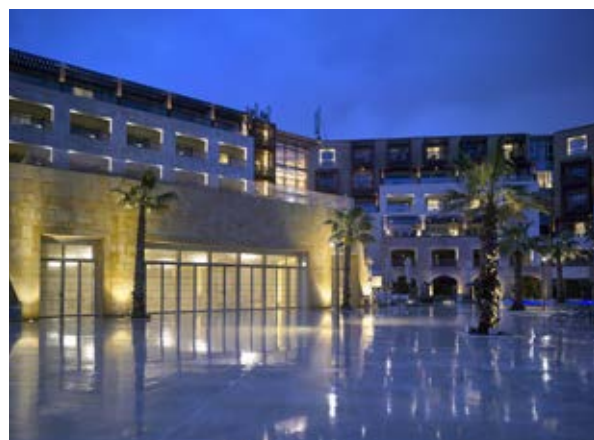

Kempinski Summerland Hotel & Resort Beirut is a popular business and leisure hotel featuring a Mediterranean flair. Preciosa developed and produced ten sparkling chandeliers for the Waltz ballroom and pre-function area.

The chandeliers are three metres in diameter and composed of hand-cut crystal beads in various sizes. Hues ranging from clear crystal, light smoky, smoky, black diamond, and plated crystal give the lighting fixtures the ideal glitz while retaining a classic feel. The bead's chain

composition creates a soft gradient of darker grey to clear crystal and the metal frame design corresponds to the carpet pattern. In addition, clusters of three pendants made from hand-blown crystal glass decorate the lobby and lobby lounge.

Kigali Convention Centre

The four chandeliers are each more than five metres in length

The Radisson Blu is part of the Kigali convention centre. Its iconic design combines Rwandan culture and modernity. Preciosa designed a cluster of four chandeliers for the hotel lobby. Each are more than five metres in length and are composed of almost 1,000 champagne-coloured glass tubes. In the ballroom we created seven rectangular chandeliers composed of clear glass tubes.



The universe was the inspiration for the Arena section of the convention centre. The dominant lighting installation is an amber sphere created from hand-blown amber glass leaves inlaid with mica and bubbles. Three rings of varying diameters were constructed from 30 centimetre glass prisms.

The Turkish chain Nusr-Et Steakhouse opened its first international venue in Dubai in 2014. A second restaurant soon followed in Abu Dhabi and Preciosa was pleased to produce a chandelier from our Collections portfolio for the dining room.

Mercury was created by well-known Czech designer Rony Plesl and is inspired by our iconic chandelier, Louis. Mercury's design reflects characteristics of the male body: strong, determined, and confident. It also offers a variable construction; Mercury's silhouette can be altered both horizontally and vertically.

The Al Wakrah Celebration Halls Complex in Al Wakrah, Qatar specializes in weddings. The exterior facade of the halls is maritime-inspired in hues of white and blue. Preciosa developed and produced the chandeliers and wall sconces for a number of different spaces throughout the large complex.

Sparkle from Crystal Valley can be found in the pre-function hall, majlis, function hall, corridors, and vestibule. Thousands of hand-blown glass shapes, engraved glass

prisms and crystal clear octagons were produced for each light. Different groupings and arrangements ensure a distinct look for every light. The largest chandelier is more than 12 metres long.

Emirates Hospital

Emirates Hospital Jumeirah is home to some of the world's leading medical professionals and features high-quality medical services with state-of-the-art technology. Preciosa was approached with a task to help make the hospital lobby more inviting, especially to children.



The two large installations we designed were both inspired by the universe—the cosmos and clouds to be exact. One of the biggest challenges with this project was the fact that the installations are suspended from a skylight. Like a trail of clouds, one of Preciosa's installations uses polished aluminium in gold for a warm reflective base, combined with large glass plates. The second design is reminiscent of a miniature galaxy formed from polished stainless steel, crystal trimmings and hand-blown frosted crystal spheres.

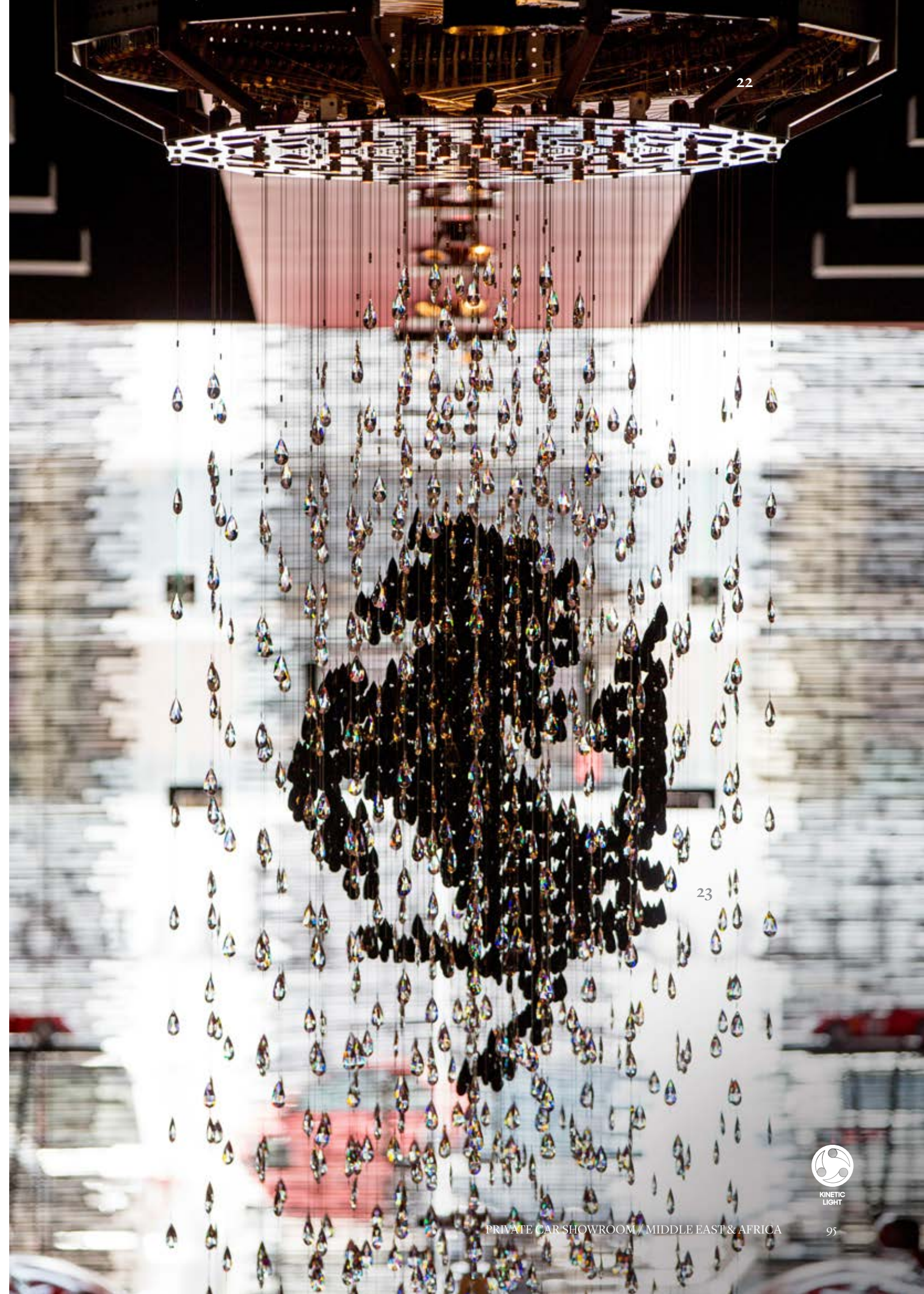
Preciosa created the car logo from black crystals to hang in the middle of the kinetic installation

For a car loving Dubai resident, Preciosa designed and produced a special kinetic installation for his private car showroom.

At Milan Design Week 2016, Preciosa introduced Crystal Automata. The kinetic installation features the mesmerizing motion of automata and the beauty of crystal. At the time, Preciosa Creative Directors Michael Vasku and Andreas Klug shared their inspiration behind the installation: “Bohemian crystal is known for its unique sparkling properties. By setting it in motion, these properties are accentuated, as distance and orientation to the light source constantly changes. So as well does the visual wonder and fascination; we bring the surprising mechanical principles of historic automata and clockworks to contemporary Preciosa lighting.”

Once the car lover experienced Crystal Automata, he was inspired to request ‘car Automata.’ Preciosa designed the car logo using black crystals and hung it amidst the moving strings of crystal. The light is 120 centimetres by 450 centimetres and is designed using Preciosa almond crystals in black and clear. The base is concrete and glittering with Preciosa Stardust.

Preciosa made more than 5000 glass pieces to create the bespoke lighting projects for the hotel

The Address Hotel is Emaar Hospitality Group's flagship hotel property and has recently undergone a full refurbishment. Preciosa worked with both the

developer's and the interior designer's ideas to create fresh and vibrant lighting throughout the hotel.

This was a large lighting undertaking – the bespoke projects feature 5500 glass pieces. The highlight is the stunning glass chandelier sparkling overhead in the reception area. The basic look is replicated in nine slightly different forms throughout the hotel. The pieces are made from hand-blown crystal glass in the shape of teardrops. Differing sizes and glass (some drops are clear, others are bubbled) make for an interesting piece. When checking in, guests are taken care of in a marvellous marble welcome area. Lights over the individual desks were designed by Preciosa, as were the glass vases at each space. A variety of other lighting from Preciosa can be found in the public areas. One special piece is the lighting fixture in the hotel's spa. The elegant wave look was created using Preciosa crystal components.

Rajmahal Theatre

The theatre features extra tall wall sconces — three metres each

The Rajmahal Theatre in Dubai draws inspiration from the royal palaces of India; with all the grandeur of an ancient Indian cinema combined with modern technology. Preciosa created a chandelier and wall sconces for the theatre's foyer.

The foyer has a palatial feel and Preciosa created lighting to complement that. The main chandelier is more than three metres tall and composed of hung plates and drops



of hand-blown glass in crystal and amber. Crystal beads add a spectacular radiance. The wall sconces are notably tall, at three metres, and are formed using hand-blown crystal glass with crystal chips in amber, opal, and crystal.

The installation in the lobby is 15 metres high and composed of Geometric Elements

Sheraton Mall of the Emirates is directly connected to the Mall of the Emirates. Preciosa created two fascinating installations; one in a lobby seating area and the other in the soaring lobby atrium. The installation in the lobby seating area is composed of more than 270 Geometric Elements in amber, clear, and bronze colours. Hand-blown glass, plate glass, and hand-cut crystal beads were used to create the shapes.

The installation in the hotel lobby is 15 metres high and ten metres wide. It is composed of 124 geometrical shapes in amber, clear, and bronze colours. The creation of this suspended sculptural lighting feature began with

the simple idea of deconstructing Arabic geometries. The concepts of transparency and reflection were used to fill in the high narrow space and support the overall size of the room.

With a design ethos inspired by nature, the Capital Bank VIP Branch in Amman, Jordan is decidedly un-bank-like. Preciosa contributed to this atmosphere by creating a



crystal chandelier flowing above a sculptural olive tree that acts as a focal point for the entire space.

The lighting installation is displayed in an inner court which was influenced by Japanese Zen gardens. Individually hand-crafted crystal leaves were created from white, sanded, clear, amber, and yellow bubbled glass. Additional crystal leaves were crafted to grace the bank's unique glass balustrades. Preciosa handmade nearly 400 leaves for Capital Bank, which give the space a calming vibe and relaxing glow.

The Kempinski Hotel Mall of the Emirates is connected to the Mall of the Emirates and underwent a room refurbishment in 2016. Preciosa designed and produced a variety of lights for two of the hotel's dining spaces.



In Noir, a cocktail bar and lounge, we created a number of different lights including chandeliers, table lamps, floor lamps, glass columns, and wall sconces. In the Olea Restaurant, we produced both pendants and lamps. Two metre tall floor lamps with metal shades were integrated into stone benches to hang above the dining tables in the restaurant. These are the largest single pressed shades Preciosa has created to date.

The lobby installation features hundreds of hand-blown glass sea pieces like coral and jellyfish

Located just minutes from downtown Abu Dhabi, the Jumeirah at Saadiyat Island Resort welcomes guests to the stunning magnificence of the most pristine beach in the Arabian Gulf. The inspiration for this exclusive complex and spa was the natural beauty of the scenery that surrounds it.

Preciosa sculpted two oceanic treasures for the hotel's main lobby and reception. Magnificent crystal tentacles wind their way through the expansive main lobby. Airy

and delicate, this artistic creation features hundreds of hand-blown glass jellyfish, spheres, and hand-crafted coral that sparkle in shades of peacock, azure, sky, aqua, and iris lustre. Crystal beads finish out the piece, adding a fresh brilliance to the elegant installation. In the reception area, Preciosa designed a one-of-a-kind glass backdrop composed of hand-blown glass plates situated at varying depths from the wall. The soft hues of blue, iris lustre, and metallic gold set the mood for a truly serene island experience.

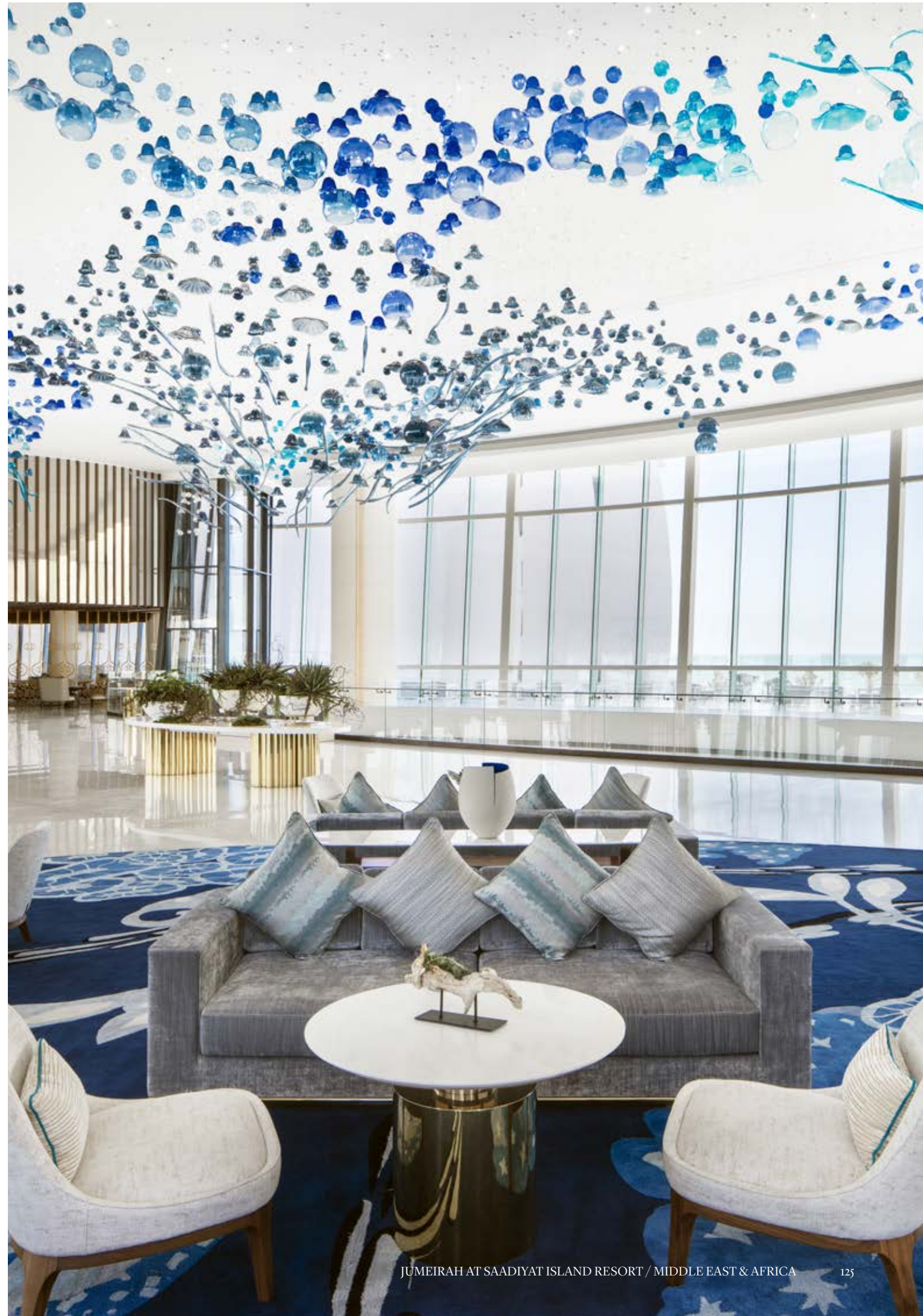

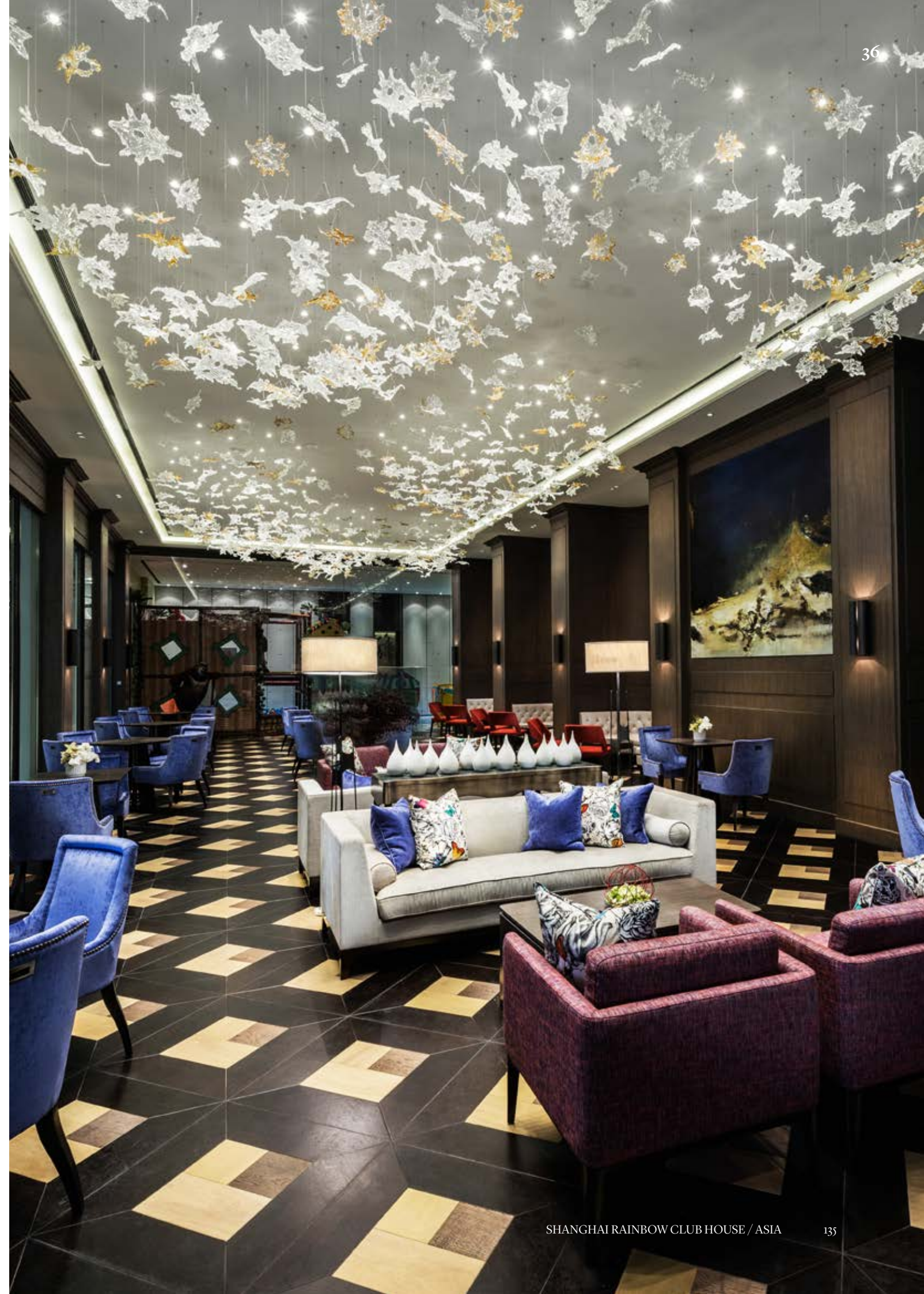

Preciosa designed and produced a breezy installation of hand-blown crystal leaves that flows through the room. The leaves are a mix of crystal with bubbles, crystal with mica and bubbles, and champagne coloured crystal with bubbles and mica. The piece consists of 1000 leaves and each one was hand-blown by the same glass master to achieve a uniform look.

A beautiful burst of blue hangs in one of the club house's windows. The round shape radiates a variety of blue tones. The piece is made from hand-blown crystal using

shades of blue, and smooth, optical décor. Other club house lighting by Preciosa can be found in the sales gallery and hanging in the grand staircase.

The Paradise Casino is located in the Paradise Hotel Busan. Preciosa was pleased to create two unique sculptures for the main lobby and atrium.

In the lobby the installation consists of rings in five colours composed from glass prisms. The smoke, rose, grey, amber, and clear prisms are illuminated by LED strips. A special lighting system allows individual rings to be dimmed. A seven-and-a-half metre long installation dominates the casino's atrium. It is formed from 16 organic shapes. Clear and frosted optical glass tubes are illuminated from inside and each shape is individually adjustable.

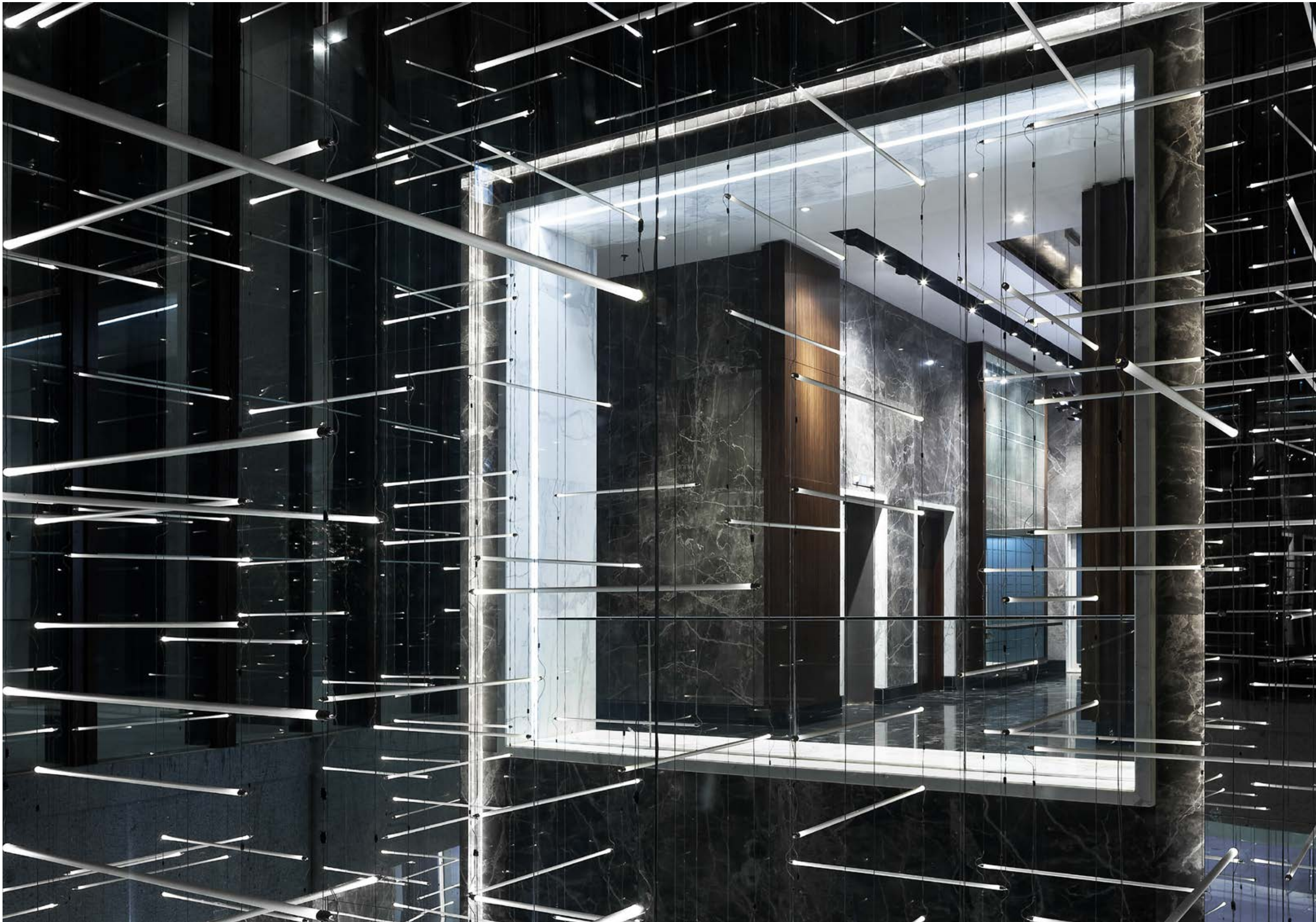

In one of its largest regional projects to date, Preciosa created more than 5300 lights for the Crown Towers Perth Hotel in Perth, Australia. We worked with three different designers to create lighting in both public and private spaces.

The guestrooms were inspired by Manhattan glamour. Preciosa delivered nearly 850 graceful bedside pendants and about 430 feature art sconces for the bathrooms. The spa boasts four chandeliers made from polished stainless steel, clear acrylic rods and hand-blown glass. Leading the way to the VIP Gaming space, Preciosa created three extensive lighting installations made from clear optical glass and weighing 260 kilograms. Inside the gaming room, players will perhaps get a little extra luck when they see our unique sconce lighting design that resembles a line of playing cards displayed on a gaming table.

More than 150 hand-blown crystal rods of varying lengths provide a perfect glow that accents the restaurant's warm colours and décor. In the Conrad's Grand Ballroom, Preciosa created six chandeliers with more than 2500 crystal rods in each one. Each chandelier features special colour-changing LED lights for an additional wow factor.

The five-star Taipei Marriott is an urban resort located along Keelung River. The interior design of the hotel is based on nature and inspired by the nearby butterfly biosphere reserve on Mt. Jiannan. Naturally, butterflies are also the main motif of Preciosa's lighting installations which are found throughout the main floor of the hotel.

When designing and developing the project, one crucial thing had to be taken into account - earthquake safety. Each butterfly had to be placed far enough from the other to prevent damage but close enough to create an illusion of richness. The delicate work resulted in wings

of blue, crystal and amber beautifully complementing the atmosphere of the interior.

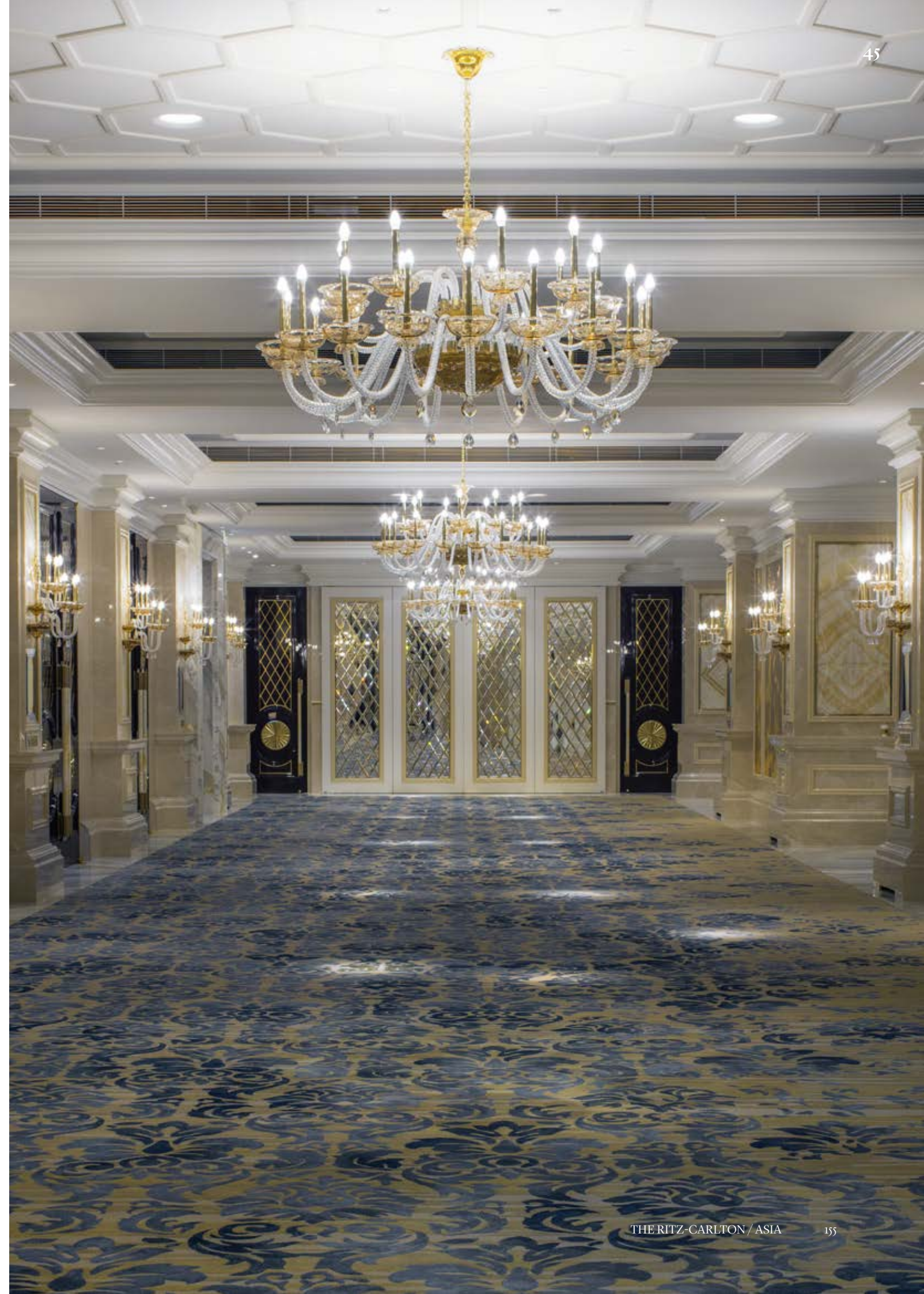
The Ritz-Carlton is a luxurious, all-suite hotel within the Cotai Galaxy resort. Preciosa chandeliers adorn several public interiors of the hotel, most notably in the ballroom. The ballroom's lighting concept can be described as early

19th century classical combined with glass in motion. There are 18 telescopic chandeliers in the ballroom, each with 36 arms. Each chandelier weighs 500 kilograms and its arms are fixed at three different levels that can repeatedly expand and fold back. A chandelier that can change its silhouette and 'grow' from two to three metres creates a visually impressive performance. The movement of the telescopic chandeliers is computer controlled. In addition different colours of light can be used to create different moods depending on the event. The movement and light come together in harmony to create an elegant and magical atmosphere.

Thousands of crystal components were created in different shapes and a variety of hues for spaces throughout the resort

MGM Cotai is the second MGM property in Macau; a high-tech resort seamlessly weaving art and entertainment into a destination experience like no other. For this very large project a number of designers collaborated on all aspects of the resort's final look. Preciosa was pleased to work with five different firms on a variety of spaces throughout the resort.

Some of the most stunning lighting installations can be found in the casino areas. In Mass Gaming, a wave of 14 chandeliers guides visitors along the corridor while in High Limit, 16 chandeliers formed from clear and frosted round glass spheres and crystal spirals shine down on the players. In Supreme Gaming, the entire space is aglow with lighting from Preciosa, including chandeliers from hand-blown glass. Wall sconces and table lamps add an additional layer of atmosphere and design.



In the Emerald Lobby, Preciosa's installation dazzles guests with a glass and metal fixture which cascades down to a bespoke candle holder underneath. In the Spectacle Lobby, guests can relax under a lovely display of amber and blue glass leaves. The MGM Cotai's gym and spa boasts a fascinating ceiling concept that combines lighting and design, using hundreds of clear, gold, amber, and dark red glass leaves.

Finally, diners in the Cantonese restaurant Chún can enjoy special lights that consist of 100 pieces of one pendant design, covering the ceiling with sparkle.

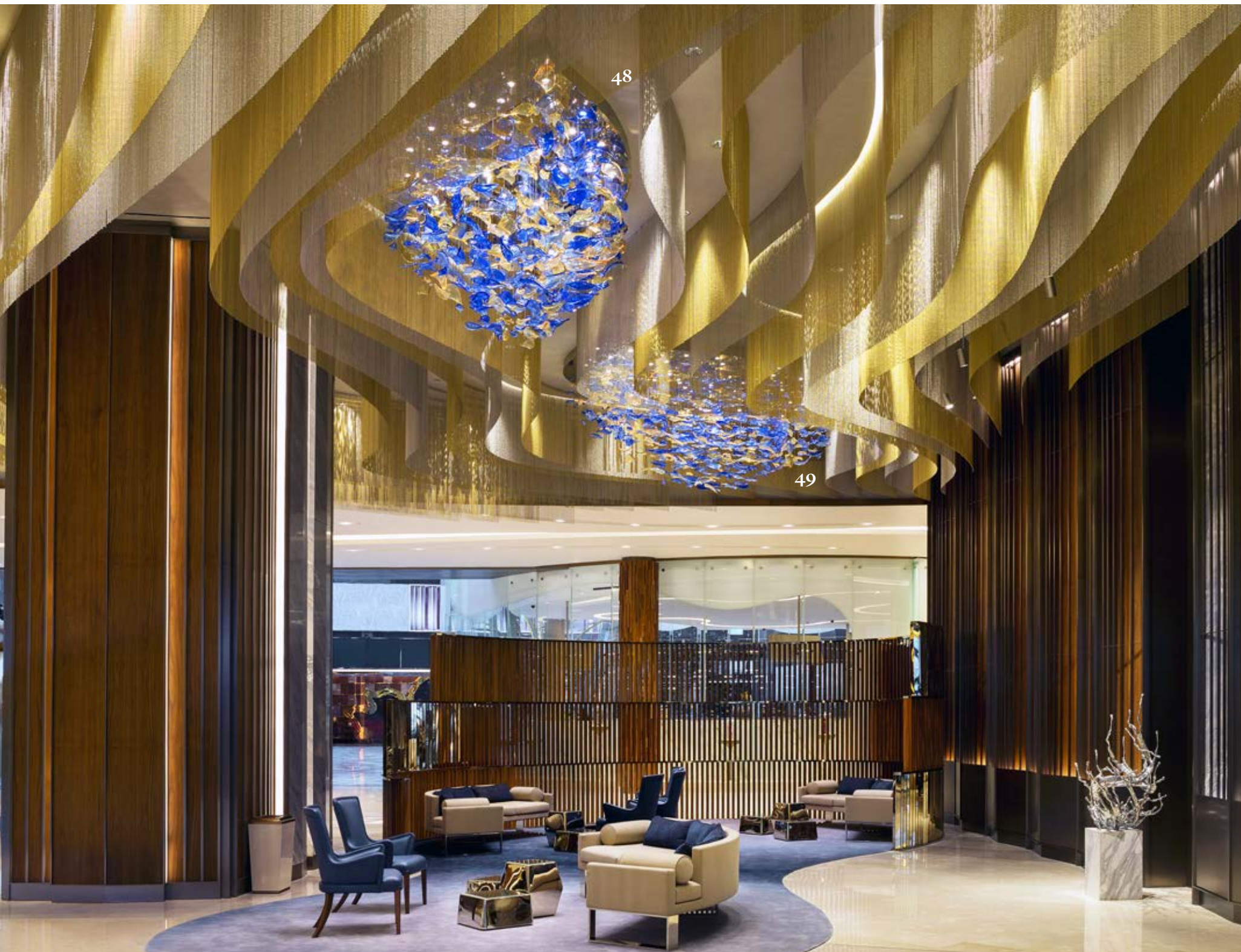

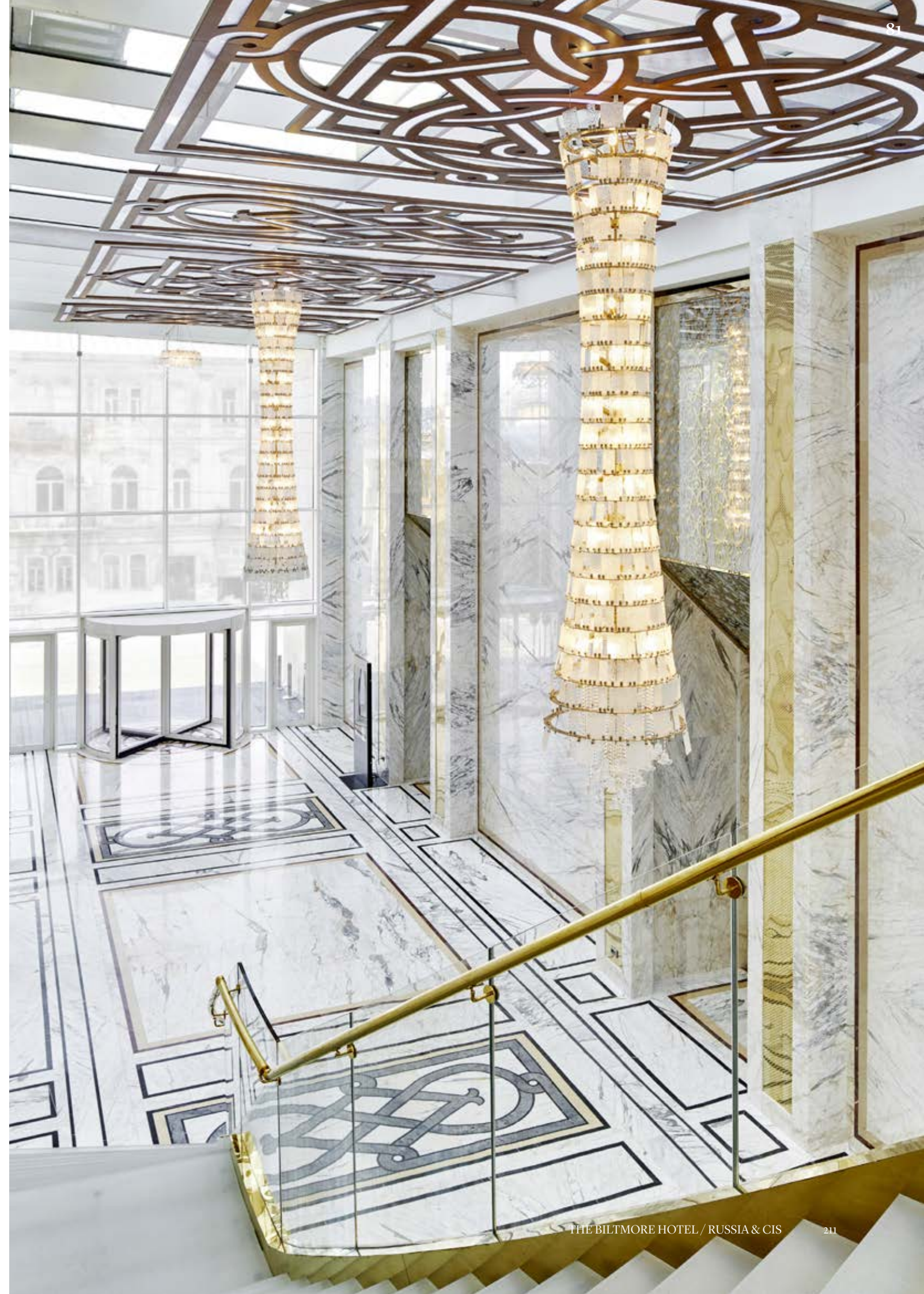


The pre-function hall is dominated by two towering chandeliers. Their distinctive shape is formed from various types of fused glass differing in texture and shape. An interesting design element in this fixture is the fissures in the outer glass shell. This feature allows the cut crystal beads to sparkle through these narrow cracks. Striking hand-blown glass bells glitter impressively in the lower part of the light.

The ballroom is decorated by ornamentally arranged smooth glass tubes which form four dominant lighting installations. The grand lobby reflects the glamour and prestige of the social elite. This feeling is enhanced by two 4.5 metre long chandeliers, each composed of 23,000 crystal octagons.

More than 5200 crystal cut balls were used to create the contemporary light sculpture in the hotel's lobby

The Paragraph Resort & Spa Shekvetili is located on the coast of the Black Sea between an ancient pine forest and the beautiful sand beaches in Shekvetili, Georgia. Preciosa was tasked with creating a series of design-forward light installations throughout the hotel which complement this unique location.

Inspired by the Georgian coastline, the first luminary that Preciosa created greets visitors in the lobby's expansive walkthrough aquarium. Consisting of nine oversized crystal spheres suspended within contemporary coral-like structures, a total of 5256 crystal cut balls were used. For the ballroom, Preciosa designed clusters of oceanic leaves in clear and iris lustre. Hanging in inverse lit "pools," six chandeliers are created from 100 handmade crystal components while three larger installations use 165 components each. A similarly designed formation winds through

marble columns in another public space made up of two sections, one 10 metres in length (with 210 hand-crafted crystal leaves) and the second four metres (140 crystal leaves).

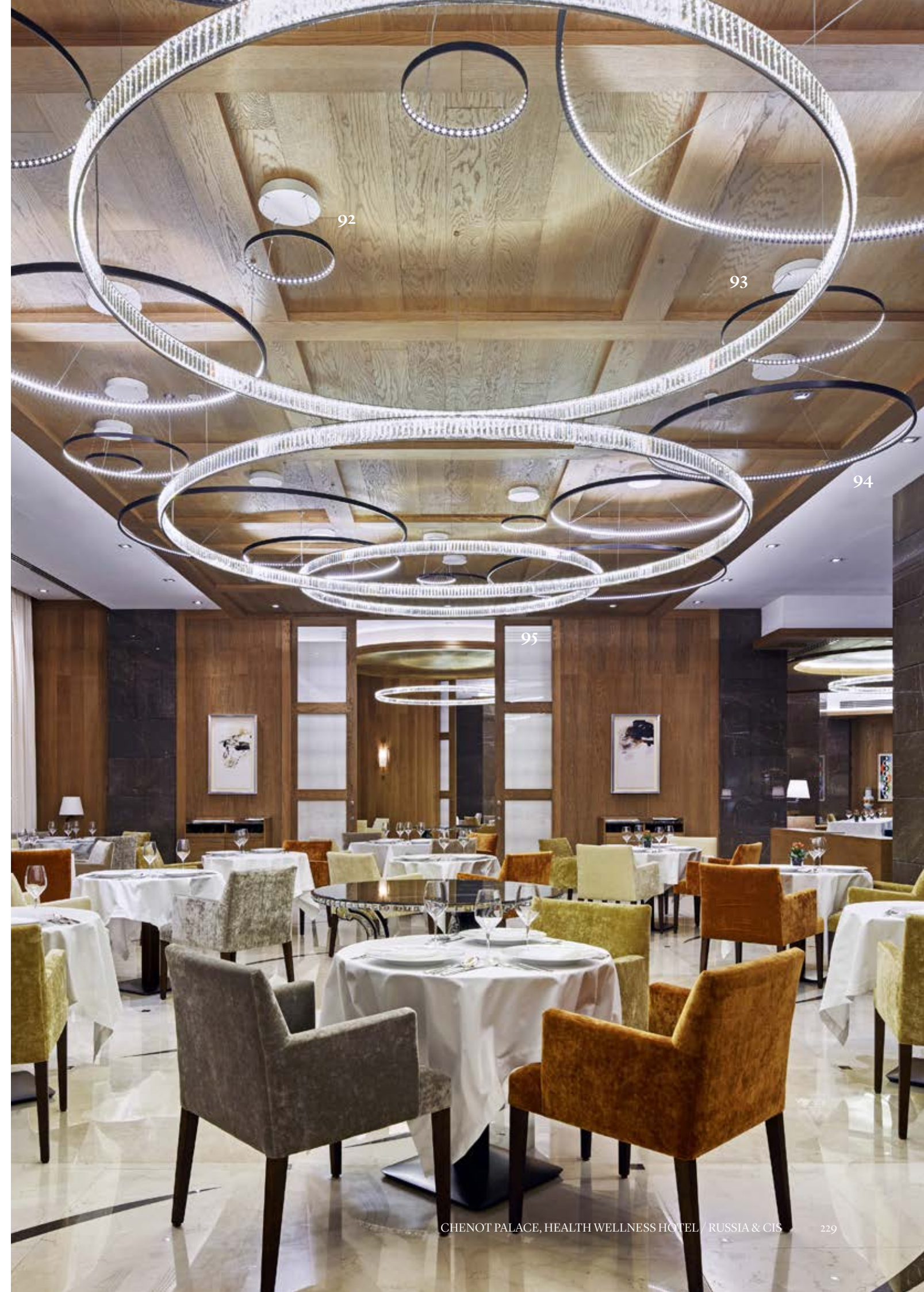

In June 2017, Kazakhstan welcomed its first The Ritz-Carlton hotel. Preciosa designed and produced a number of fascinating lighting installations for the property.

Guests are welcomed to the hotel with two wall art features placed at the reception desk and lobby lift area. The features are composed of brass-casted branches with hand blown crystal drops. To create

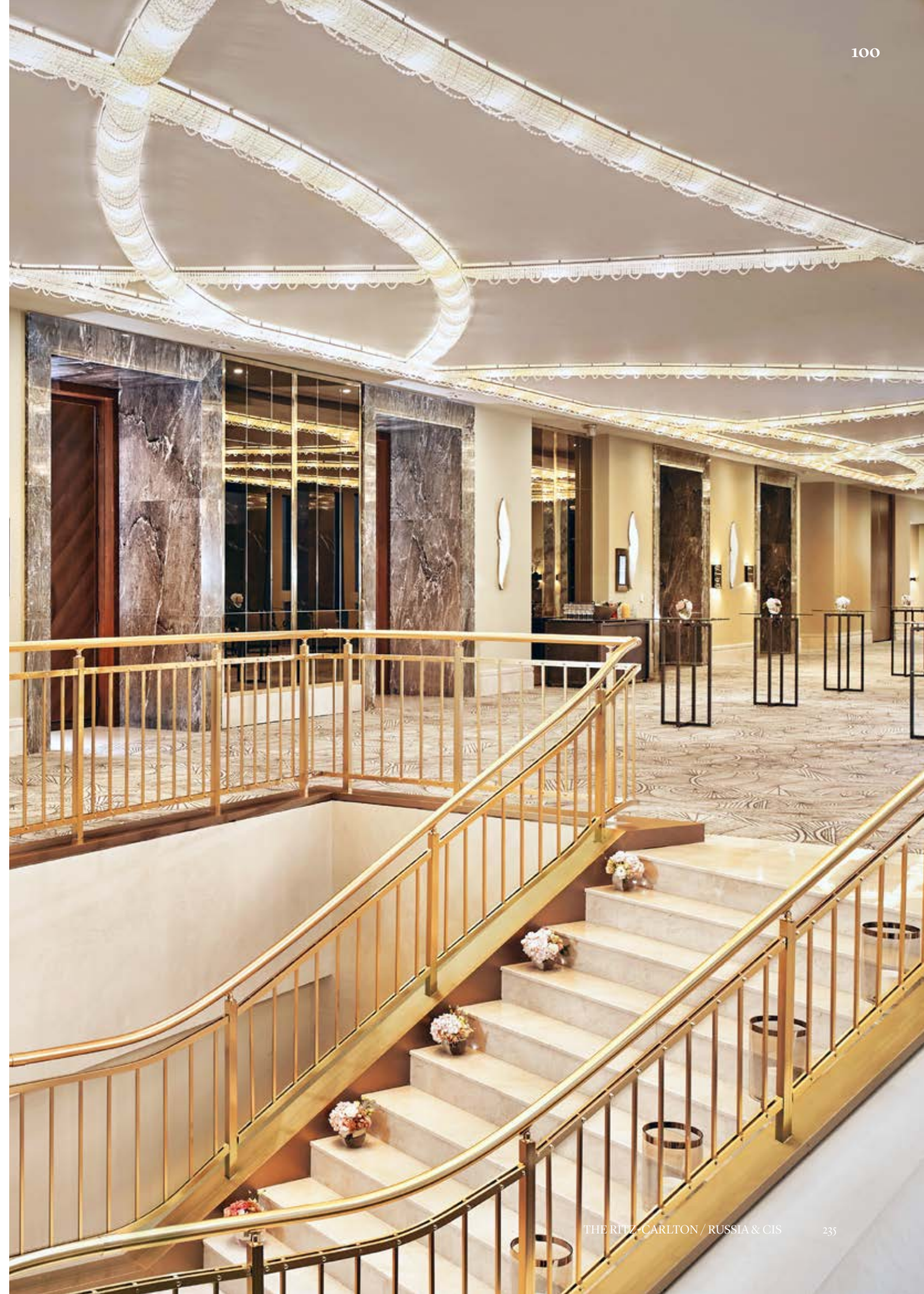


the most authentic looking pieces, we custom-produced large moulds in order to cast 1-metre long branches for the feature. Each centimetre of the branches were shaped and structured by hand.

An impressive 3-metre wide chandelier graces the hotel's lobby. Additional lighting from Preciosa can also be found in the hotel's large ballroom, including the entry way and pre-function space. In this room, we again created something out of the ordinary. More than 290,000 Preciosa cut lead crystal octagons were used. Strung end-to-end, they would stretch more than four kilometres. It took specialists more than 1300 hours to string together the delicate pieces.

A 120-centimetre chandelier made from cut crystal components is literally the room's crowning touch.

Authentic American flavours meet the beautiful local ambience of the Caucasus region at Hard Rock Cafe Baku. The restaurant is housed in a well-known local building, famed for being the home of the Azerbaijan Cinema in the 20th century. The large restaurant covers more than 1300 square metres of space.



The spirit of rock n' roll is enhanced by a remarkable black cloud composed of glitter balls produced in Crystal Valley. The feature is more than nine metres high and almost 11 metres in width and hangs from the second to the first levels of the restaurant. This dominant feature consists of 74 black sparkling mirror balls ranging in diameter from 15 centimetres to 160 centimetres. The use of materials allows for the shimmering hues of the space's blues and greens to beautifully reflect. The lighting is a bold addition to the otherwise low-key décor.

Hutchinson Shores' nautical luxury can be felt the minute you enter the lobby and spot a duo of dangling sailfish. Preciosa produced the sailfish based on the designer's inspiration. Both are 300 centimetres long and made of hand-blown glass, slumped glass, brass, and stainless steel. Hand-blown blue fish and crystal bubbles drift around the sailfish, giving the entire installation a floating feel. Preciosa carried the sea muse through to the Kingfish Ballroom. Reminiscent of floating jellyfish, Preciosa designed three chandeliers, each made of 14 plates of

hand-blown glass created in four different sizes and colours--light blue with opal, light blue, clear with opal and clear. A larger style of these chandeliers, made with 29 plates, can be found in the pre-function area, while a meeting room features a smaller version.

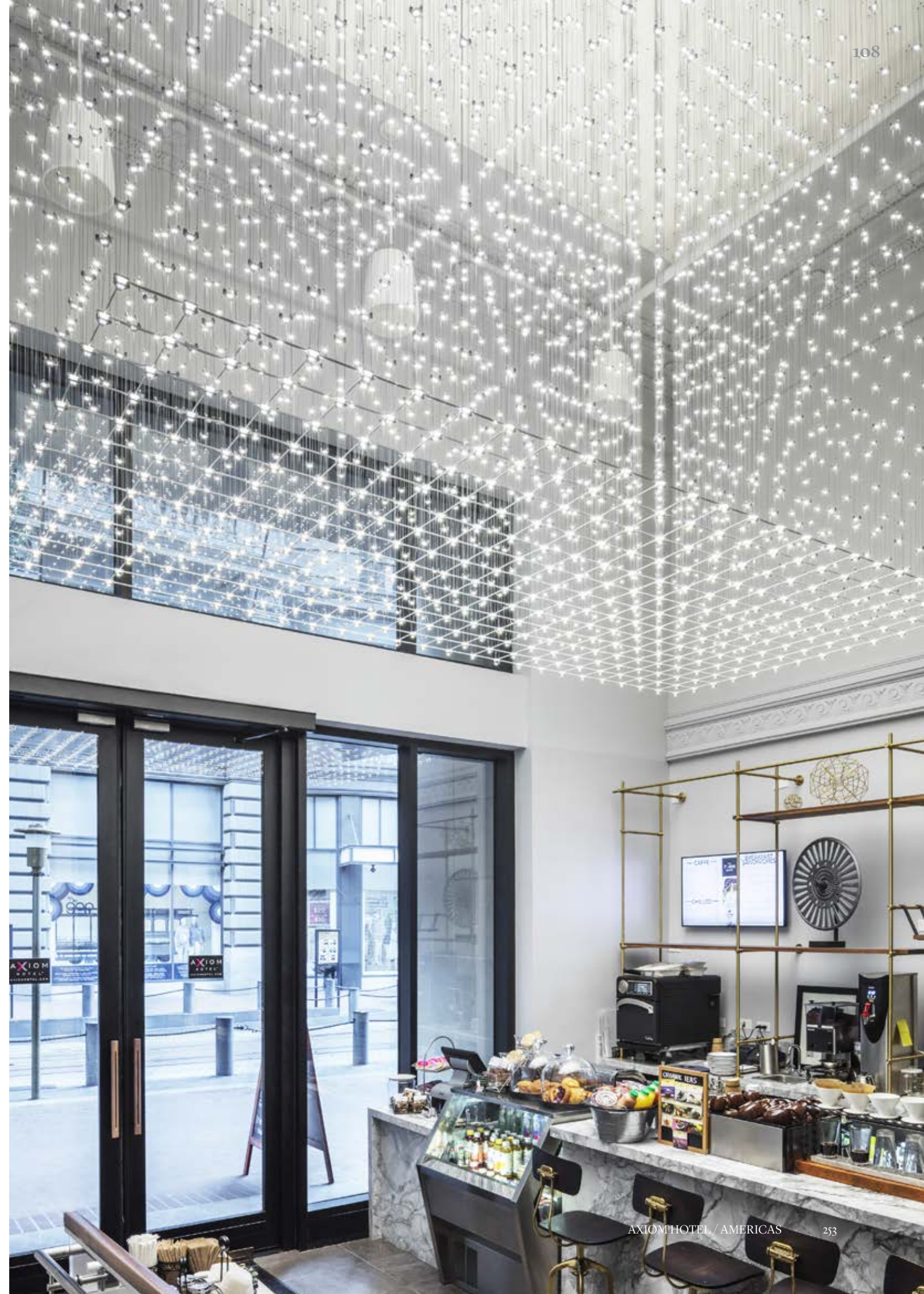

The latest LED technology combined with top quality materials and Preciosa's designer finishes helped complement the other stylish furnishings in these public spaces.

The wide-range of lighting styles is notable in this refurbishment. The ballroom features classic crystal



chandeliers while hallways feature more minimalistic crystal prism chandeliers. Wall sconces featured heavily through the project as did unique crystal and metal designs.

Lucky Dragon *Hotel & Casino*

The Lucky Dragon Hotel & Casino Las Vegas was a boutique-style casino resort designed to create an authentic Asian gaming experience. The centrepiece of the casino was a dragon chandelier designed and installed according to the principles of Feng Shui.

Feng Shui governed the dimensions of the dragon, the number of ornaments, and even the orientation of it in the casino area. The body of the dragon part of the chandelier was nearly seven metres long and built from 762 hand-blown glass scales. The dragon was surrounded

by 288 hand-blown glass orbs that were also suspended from the ceiling. The dragon's head was more than one metre high. Installation of the 1.25 ton glass piece took Preciosa two weeks. Sadly, the Lucky Dragon Casino is now closed.

A redesign of the Marriott Marquis San Diego Marina's existing amenity spaces and all of the meeting spaces below the grand hotel's north and south guestroom towers gave the popular business property a wonderful new look inspired by and reminiscent of the Pacific Ocean's sand and surf.

Preciosa developed sophisticated chandeliers using high quality optical glass twisted tubes for the ballroom. RGBW LED's were used and a lighting control system was installed which allows the hotel to change the lighting's colours to whatever they desire. In the Marriott

Hall North pre-function area there are three installations of Preciosa's own Falling Flowers design. These are composed from 200 hand-blown Bohemian crystal glass flowers in azure, frosted, and black diamond finishes.

The Grand Hyatt Washington's public space underwent a refurbishment and Preciosa was pleased to assist, specifically with the new multi-storey chandelier in the atrium as well as a light and focal wall in the grand staircase connecting the lobby and 1B levels.

The multi-storey lighting fixture in the atrium is more than 45 metres high. Each hanging section boasts 272 glass tubes covered with Stardust on the inner

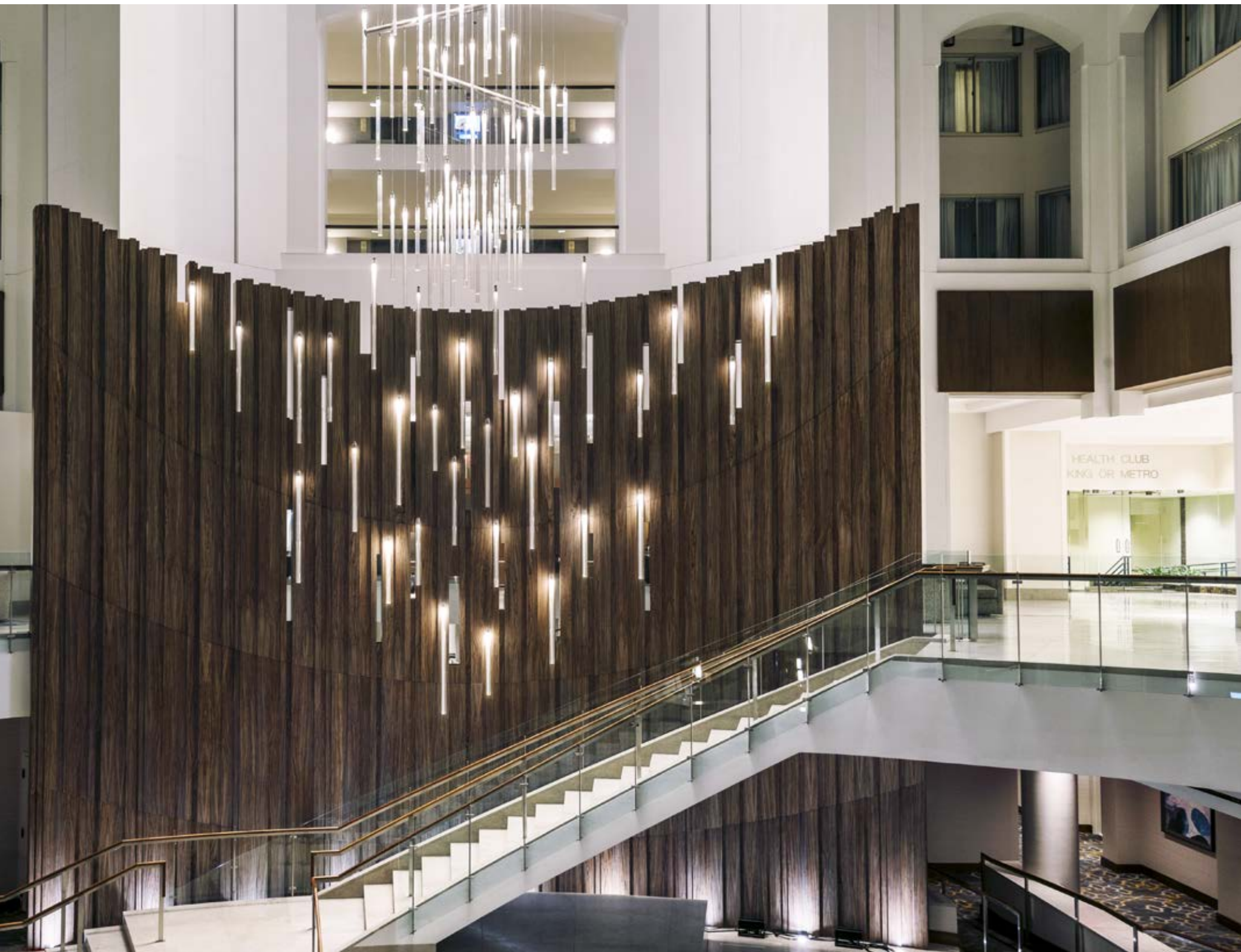

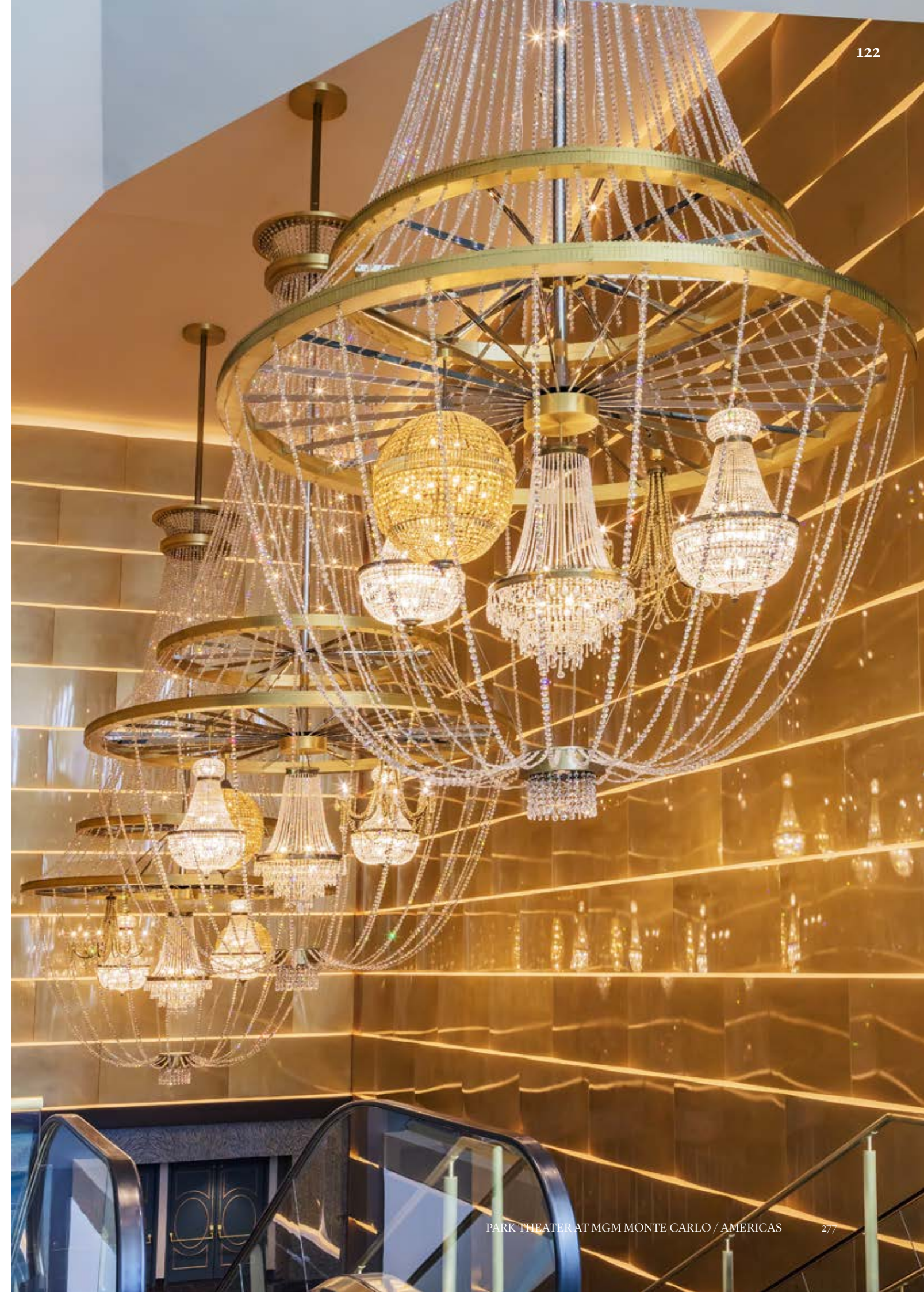
We developed and produced three colossal chandeliers for the theatre's lobby. Each piece weighs 1.1 tons; is more than nine metres high and nearly five metres wide. The

Renaissance Dallas at Plano Legacy West Hotel is a large premium property for business and leisure travellers. Preciosa created a number of bespoke lighting pieces throughout the hotel.

The unmistakable dominance in the pre-function area of the meeting spaces is the glass ribbon sculpture that interlaces between the columns. It is made of glass tubes coated in Preciosa's own Stardust to escalate its brilliance. Organic shaped chandeliers in the Junior Ballroom are in the shape of roses with petals composed of thousands of crystal beads.



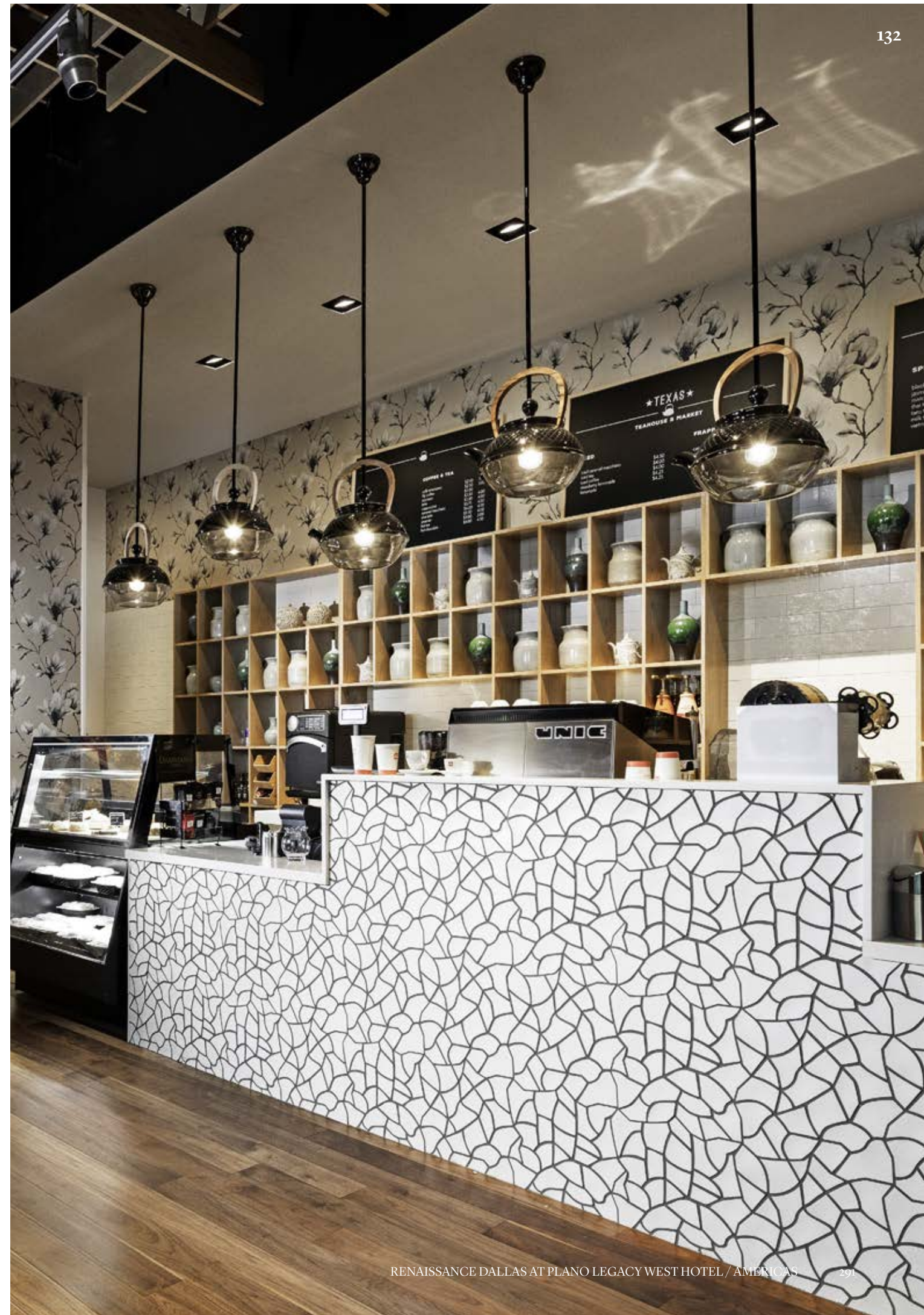
The lighting in OMA, an Asian-fusion restaurant, is comprised of 36 metal birdcages in a mix of hand-painted gold, antique brass, and rubbed brass. A 2-metre sculptured metal pendant is the focal feature of the R Lounge Communal Table. Hand-blown black and smoky glass teapots add an element of whimsy to the Teahouse. In the lobby, guests are welcomed with an airy lighting sculpture composed of 520 clear crystal balls creating a concave dome. In the elevator lobby, a twisted glass sculpture of four-sided, multi-sized plates have been carefully arranged to create a twirly pendant.

Preciosa played on the industrial edge when producing the lighting for much of the hotel. A few highlights include the ten large metal and glass chandeliers dominating the lobby hallway. The design blends perfectly with the hallway's bridge trusses. In the Pin + Proof



speakeasy and bowling alley, guests can relax in the opulent atmosphere, and admire the clever metal sphere chandelier adorned with light bulbs. Viceroy Chicago strives to deliver a bespoke experience reflecting the art, lifestyle and design of its vibrant landscape to every guest. Preciosa designed, produced and installed lightings for several spaces throughout the property.



The Devereaux rooftop bar is adorned with pendants and table lamps from Preciosa. In the meeting and event space, Preciosa wall sconces can be found in the 4th floor pre-function area as well as pendants in the ballroom. The bespoke pendants are composed of various sizes of hand-blown crystal glass balls in grey, champagne, and white frosted colours. Integrated dimmable LED light sources allow the atmosphere in the ballroom to be changed according to event organizers' wishes. The reception is brightened by Preciosa table lamps and a light bronze three metre wide crystal ring chandelier. More than 300 crystals spectacularly shine, all lit by an LED strip. The chandelier in the 1st floor library appears from below to be a blooming flower adorned with alabaster petals.

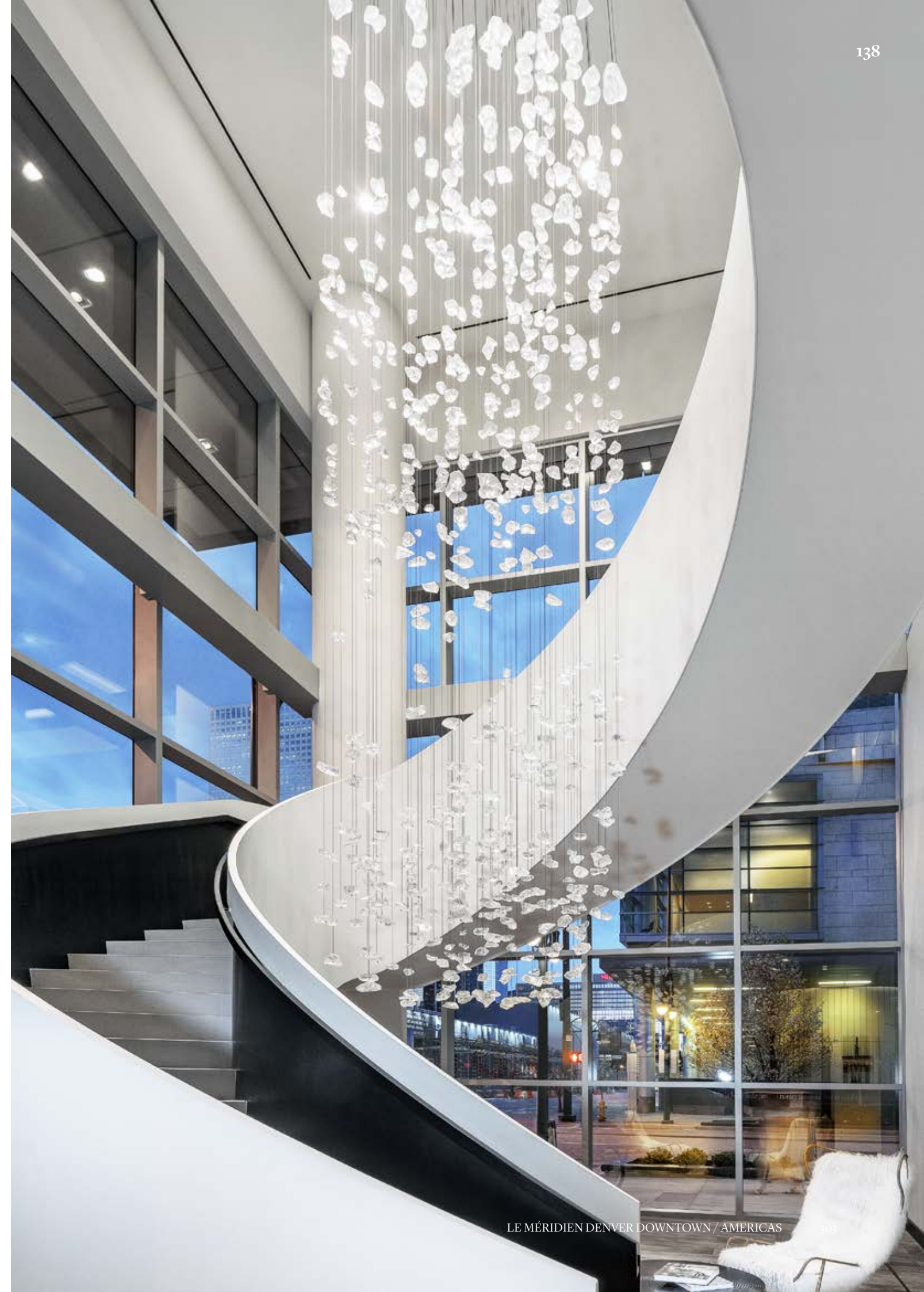


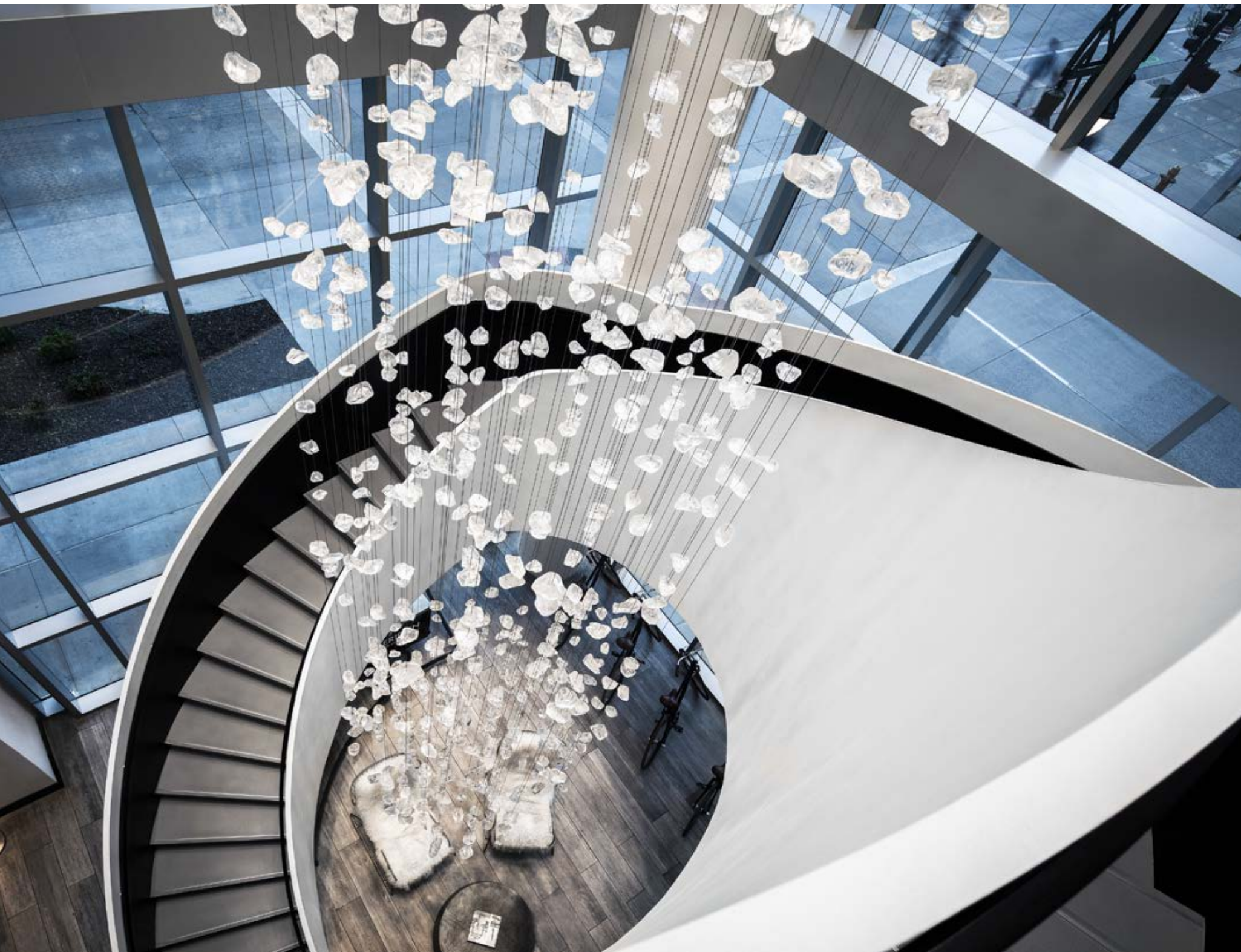

There may not be enough superlatives to describe the luxury that is the Post Oak Hotel in Houston, Texas. Preciosa produced a large number of chandeliers and lamps in both the Post Oak's restaurants and public spaces.

The Bloom & Bee's floral design is reflected in the hand-blown glass lighting that seems to beg diners to look up and smile. Preciosa shaped plates, bells and bowls in shades of blue and green, both with a pearl effect, plus crystal for a perfect lighting accompaniment to this energetic space. The lighting installation in the Bouchée Patisserie is a swooping comma shape around the ceiling.

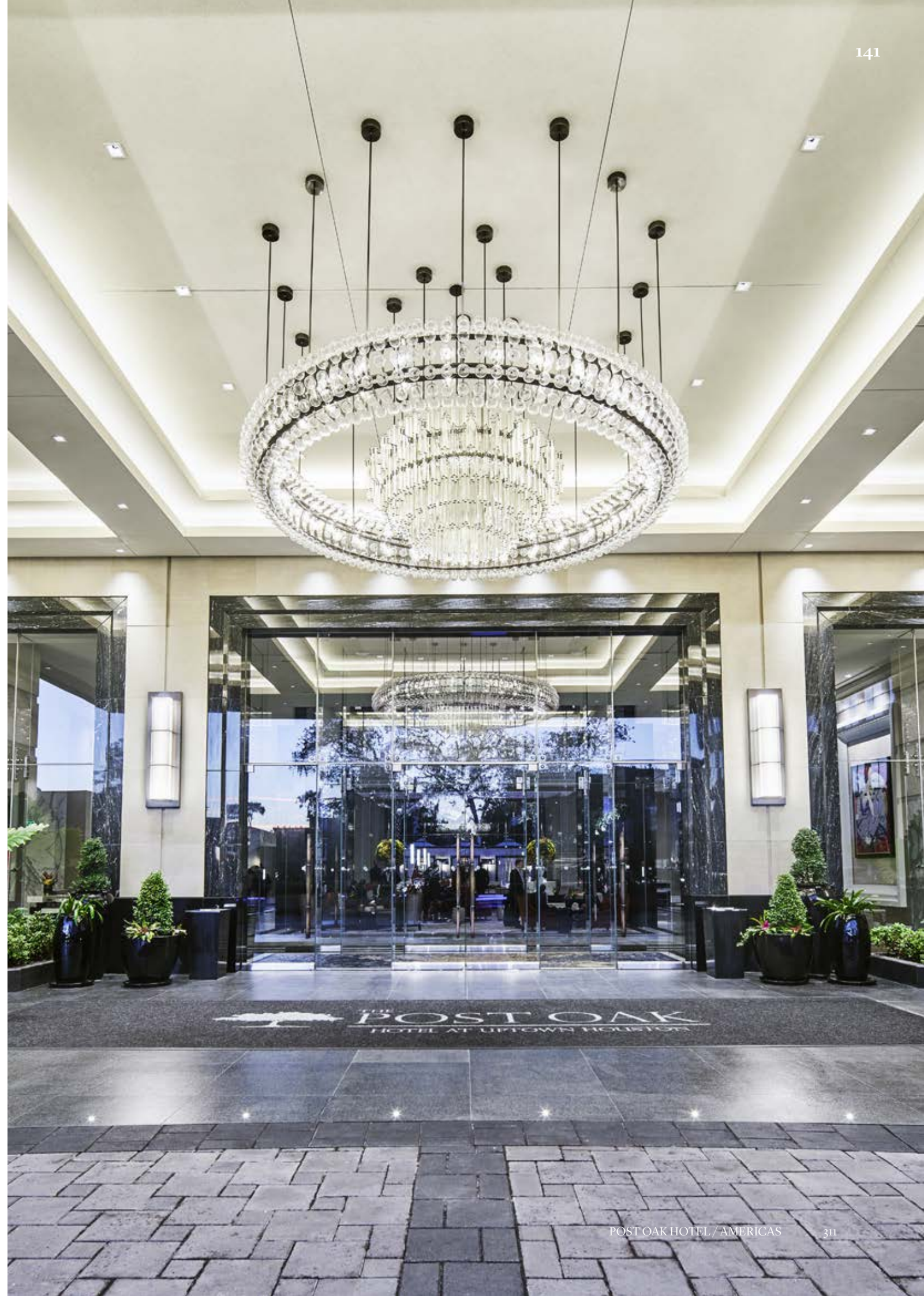
You'll find more than 800 opal spheres in varying sizes that create a bright yet refined atmosphere.

Guests are greeted before entering the hotel by a glowing 2-in-1 chandelier crafted from both crystal rods and hand-blown crystal balls. At nearly ten metres, no one can miss the brilliance of the installation cascading through one of the staircases. This ribbon of trimmings is made from a combination of cut beads and hand-blown crystal drops. Preciosa was also pleased to produce exterior pool lighting; special lit glass panels in the elevator lobby plus other crystal lighting designs that help define the opulent look of the Post Oak Hotel.

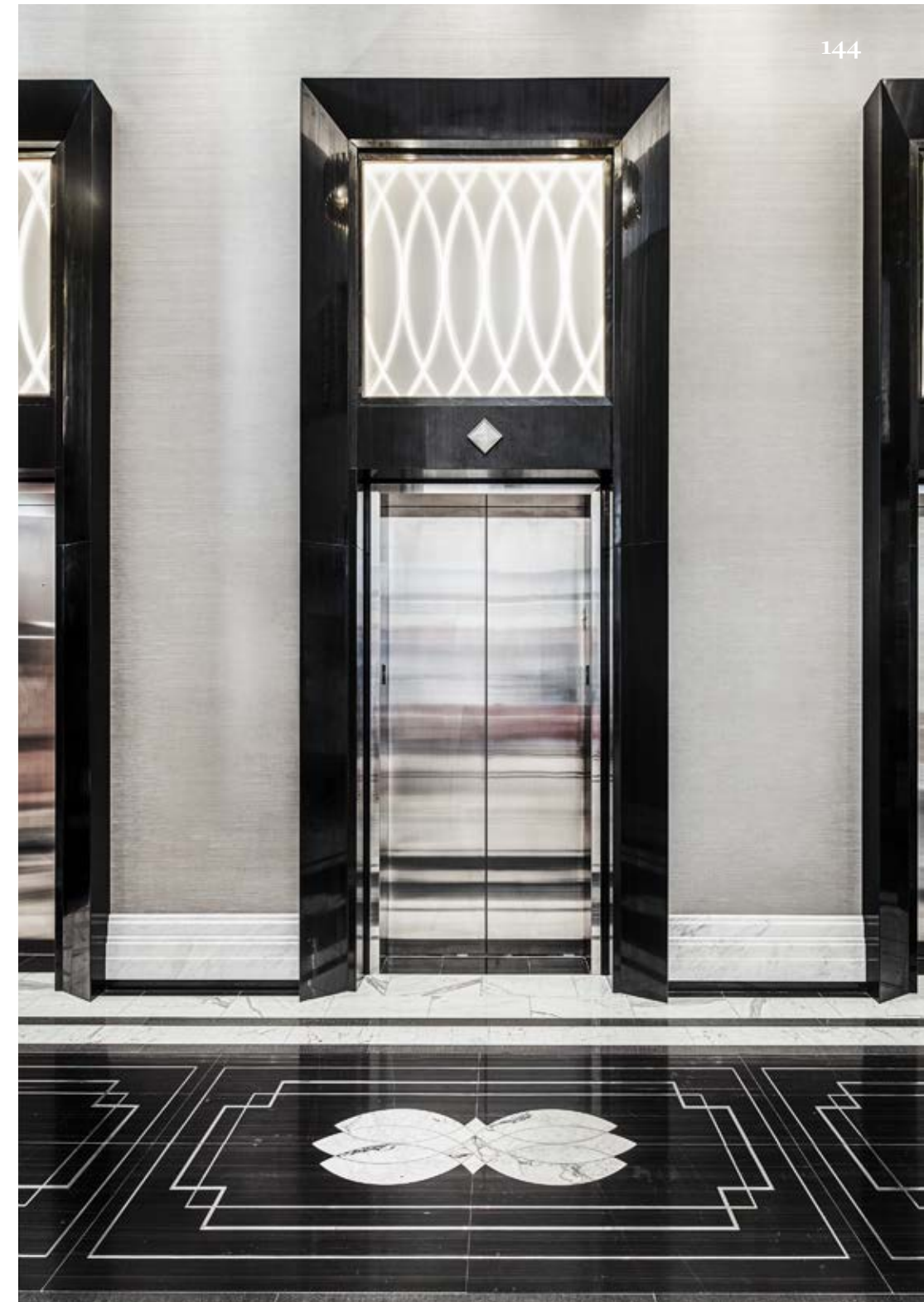

produced, and installed the Ridge Stone Wall in the lobby as well as additional lights in the lobby and Eno Vino Wine Bar & Bistro Lounge

The majestic Ridge Stone Wall is the largest RGB wall Preciosa has developed and realized to date. The wall is a cinematic display made up of shaped glass stones, where each stone makes up one pixel. The challenge for Preciosa's Innovation Lab was to create a printed circuit board and implement a LED panel into the original Ridge Stone model, which was created by designers J. Vacek and M. Smid. The result is a 20 metre square printed circuit board which can be modified via remote access. The video scene can also be changed by hotel staff using a tablet application.

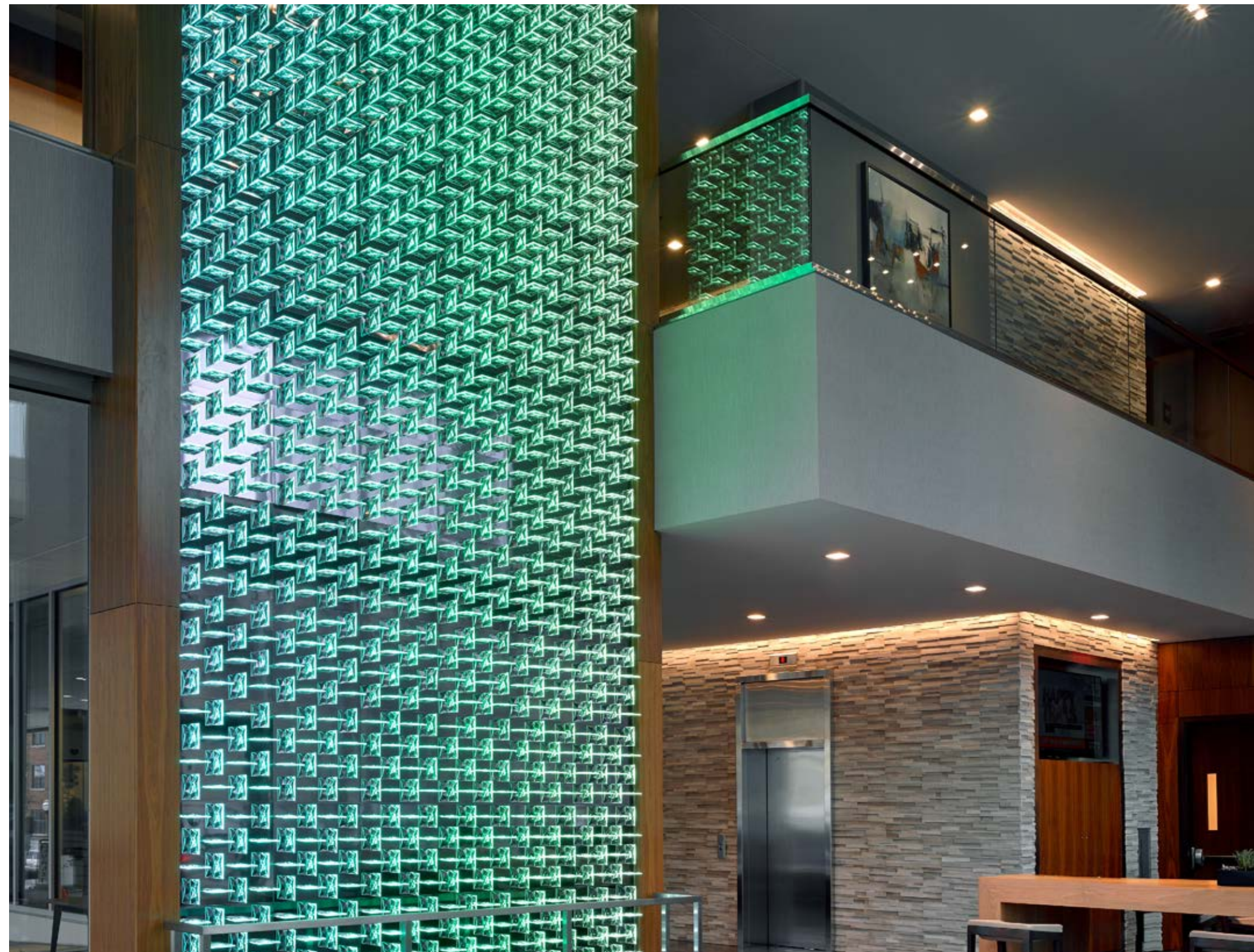
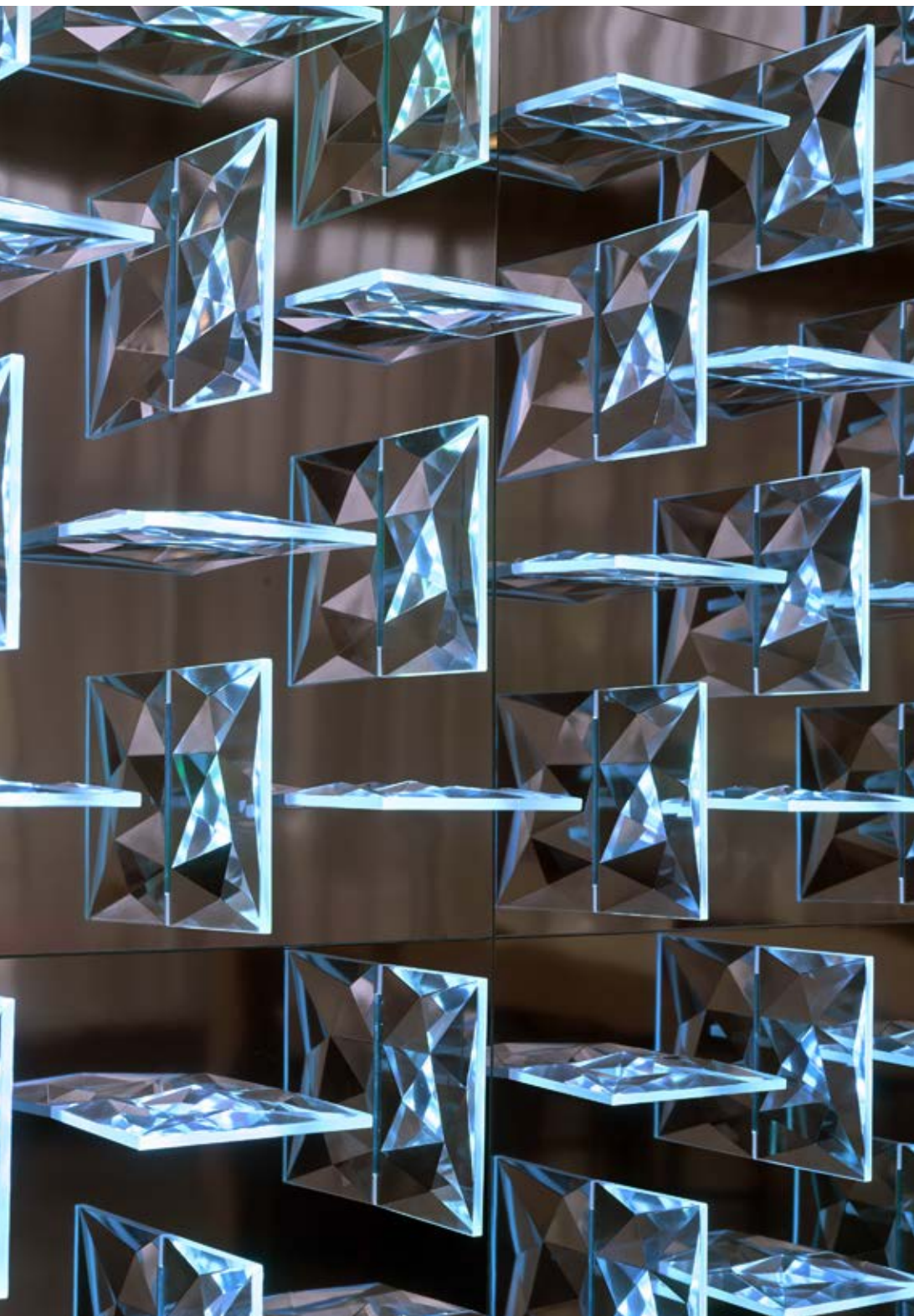
